After School Program

The City of Tempe offers this after school program for teens receiving Special Education services who attend Mt. Point, Tempe H.S., Corona, McClintock or Marcos de Niza during the 2009-2010 school year.

Fees:

\$40 per week. Payments may be made to the program staff or at the Tempe Parks and Recreation office, 3500 S. Rural Rd (payments will not be accepted in the KidZone/Social Services office).

Checks should be made out to the City of Tempe.

*The City of Tempe Parks and Recreation program has a contract with the Department of Developmental Disabilities (DDD). The case manager must authorize Day Treatment and Training services prior to the student's participation in the program.

Registration:

Parents/guardians must complete a registration form for each student who will be participating in the program. Online registration will be unavailable.

Additional forms may be downloaded from the website www.tempe.gov/adaptedrecreation.

Transportation:

TUHSD will provide transportation from the student's school to Marcos de Niza. It is the parent's responsibility to arrange transportation for your child. Please contact your child's teacher to make arrangements. Parents/guardians are responsible for transportation home. Students must be picked up prior to 6 pm.

Half Days/Holidays:

The program will be closed on all City recognized holidays and on all days in which the schools are closed. Due to the limited availability of facilities, the program follows only the Marcos de Niza half day schedule.

Program Format:

The program's primary focus is life skill enrichment. It is requested that parents provide the staff with a copy of the student's IEP as this will be helpful in planning weekly activities. Some of the many activities include soccer, frisbee, crafts, card games, board games, and many more!

Students may occasionally take off site trips in a City of Tempe vehicle. Permission from the parents/guardians will be required.
