REGISTRATION GUIDELINES

- These programs have a limited number of spaces available.
- Registration is on a first come, first served basis and takes place, in person, at the Escalante Community Center.
- One parent/guardian registers one child and sibling(s).
- Optional: may pay for program in two payments (see form).

PROGRAM GUIDELINES

- A parent/guardian must bring their child to start of each class and pick up their child at the end of each class. (If a parent/guardian is consistently late, or the student is consistently absent, the child may be dropped from class.)
- A parent/guardian must walk their child into the building and into the classroom. If someone other than the parent or guardian will pick up the child, staff must be informed. Children will only be released to a parent or authorized person.
- The Early Childhood Ed Program provides one snack and juice or water for each child. Please inform staff if your child has a food allergy. Parents can provide their student with a "simple snack" to eat during snack time.
- ECEP guidelines and daily activities are detailed in the "Parent Handbook" and available during first week of classes.
