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FRIENDLY REMINDERS:

- Please send a lunch to school each day for your child. If you would like your child to receive lunch from the district, please reach out to Ms. Kaitlyn for directions!
- Please bring a reusable water bottle for your child daily.
- If you provide nap time bedding, it will be sent home every FRIDAY. Please return them on the following MONDAY.
- All students will have a "mailbox" or folder that their artwork, school work, and any additional paperwork will be placed in. Check "mailboxes" daily.
- Please provide an extra change of clothes for child's cubbie. Accidents can happen (potty, food, playing, etc.)
- To help your child prepare for "big school," it is highly encouraged for your child to bring a backpack to school daily. This will make it easier to take things to and from school as well.
- When dropping off/picking up your child please use the gate off of Roosevelt Street. Please only share pin code with those authorized to pick up your child.
- If your child is sick, or has a fever 99.8 degrees or higher, please keep them at home and refer to our illness policy in our handbook.
- Late pick-up is anytime after 6:00pm. (1-15 minutes late = \$10/each additional 15 minutes = \$10) *after 5 late pickups your child may be removed from the program
- We ask that your child arrive to school no later than 8:30am. Curriculum starts promptly at 8:30am.

ABSENCE POLICY:

- If your child is going to be absent or late, please notify the preschool by emailing or calling the Site Coordinator, Kaitlyn Profiri. (Note: calling your student out at Getz campus DOES NOT also call them out for Kid Zone.)
