

# FINAL DETERMINATION OF PETITION SUFFICIENCY

## REFERENDUM PETITION – REF2022.06

Two (2) signature pages bearing 28 signatures for referendum petition serial number REF2022.06 have been refused for filing in this office as provided by law.

A total of 4,750 of the signatures included on the remaining 396 petition sheets were found to be eligible for further review.

From those eligible, a 5% random sample was drawn utilizing the sample matrix provided by the office of the Arizona Secretary of State.

Of the total random sample of 238 signatures, a total of 75 signatures were invalidated by the office of the Maricopa County Recorder resulting in a failure rate of 31.51 percent.

After subtraction of the invalidated signatures and reduction by the failure rate, the actual number of remaining signatures for the noted referendum is 3,202, which is equal to or in excess of the minimum 2,134 legally required to place a referendum measure on the May 16, 2023 Special Election ballot.

The number of valid signatures filed with this petition, based on the random sample, equals at least one hundred percent of the minimum required.
