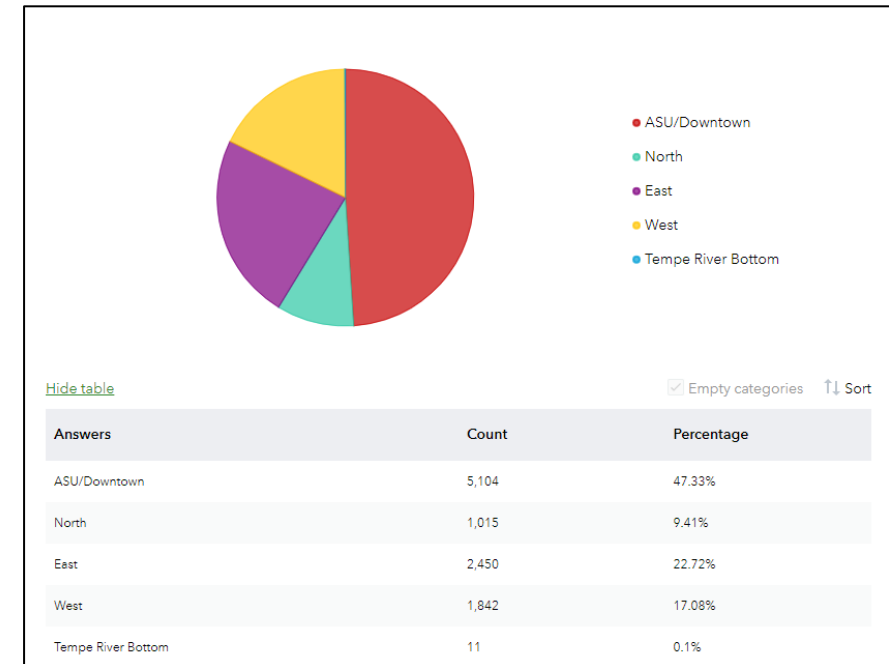

# Reported Encampment's Follow Up



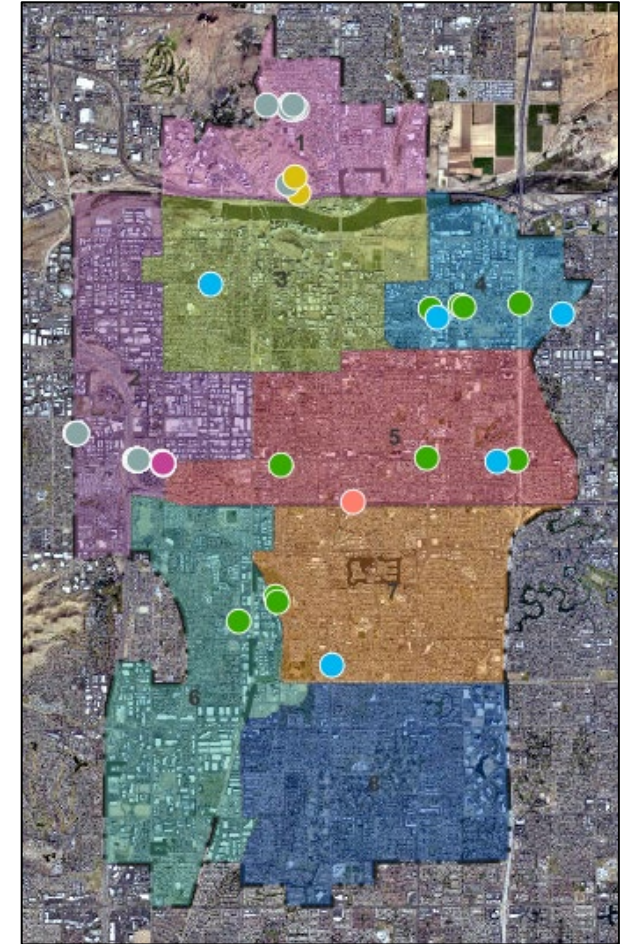
