
Agenda Item: 3

ACTION: Request approval to abate public nuisance items at the Moore Property located at 438 W. Hermosa Drive. The applicant is the City of Tempe – Code Compliance.

FISCAL IMPACT: \$3195 for abatement request: front yard landscape cleanup, remove trash, litter & debris from all yard areas, remove dead fronds from palm trees on property.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff – Approval of 180-day open abatement.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: City of Tempe – Code Compliance Section requests approval to abate items in violation of the Tempe City Code at the MOORE PROPERTY. The details of this case represent several months of correspondence for compliance with the property owner. Staff requests the approval of abatement of the following nuisance items under Complaint CE225066: front yard landscape cleanup, remove trash, litter & debris from all yard areas, remove dead fronds from palm trees on property.

COMMENTS:

Code Compliance is requesting approval to abate the Moore Property located at 438 W. Hermosa Drive, in the R1-6 Single Family Residential district. This case was initiated 08/31/2022, after which Code Compliance has attempted to obtain compliance through correspondence with the property owner regarding violations of the Tempe City Code.

Without the intervention of abatement, the property will continue to deteriorate. It is therefore requested that the City of Tempe Community Development Hearing Officer approve a 180-day open abatement of this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code.

FINDINGS:

08.31.2022: An Anonymous complaint was received regarding junk / debris across the front / back yard areas including a deteriorated landscape / dead palm fronds on tree/s and putrid odors under garage. This was verified and a first notice was mailed to the property owner.

09.13.2022: At the second inspection no corrective actions had taken place and a final notice was mailed to the property.

09.27.2022: At the final inspection no corrective actions had taken place or contact initiated and a final warning was post on property. A final extension was granted via flier posted on the property. The final warning included a final correction date to avoid further actions or penalty.

10.11.2022: At this inspection no corrective actions had taken place nor communication initiated. Additionally, anonymous complaints were received regarding the deteriorated state of the overgrown palm tree and dead fronds. A first citation was issued after the property was not brought into compliance.

11.14.2022: After multiple failed attempts to reach the owner and citation, direction was taken from management. Due to the lack of communication with the property owner/s and a rapidly deteriorating property the abatement was initiated.

12.15.2022: All elements were gathered, and the abatement packet was completed. The location will be set for the January 17th, 2023 Hearing Officer Agenda.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

Respectfully submitted,

I recommend an abatement of the nuisance violations at the property located at 438 W HERMOSA DR due to property owner's failure to bring property into compliance with Tempe City Codes CC 21-3.b.1 & CC 21-3.B.8. MOORE MARILYN C has been given ample time to come into compliance and maintain the property. The property owner has been issued a civil citation and has failed to appear to court. There has been no indication that the property owner will bring the property into compliance. The property represents a health hazard and an eyesore to the community.

Without the intervention of abatement, the property will continue to deteriorate. I therefore make a request to the City of Tempe Community Development Hearing Officer for authorization to abate this public nuisance in accordance with section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code and authorization of multiple abatements for a period not to exceed one hundred eighty (180) days from the previous abatement order.

This serves as notification of the City of Tempe's intentions regarding the abatement of code violations on the following described property:

This office will submit this complaint to the Community Development Abatement Hearing Officer located at the Tempe City Council Chambers on 01/17/2023. We are requesting Hearing Officer Authorization to abate this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code by removal and repair of:

Violation of City of Tempe Code

CC 21-3.b.1

A nuisance includes any one (1) or more of the following conditions: Filthy, littered, debris or trash-covered exterior areas, including exterior areas under any roof not enclosed by the walls, doors or windows of any building; including, but not limited to, areas that contain items such as cans, bottles, wood, metal, plastic, rags, boxes, paper, tires, auto parts; unused, inoperable, worn out or discarded appliances or other household items; lumber, scrap iron, tin and other metal not neatly piled, or anything whatsoever that is or may become a hazard to public health and safety, or that may harbor insect, rodent or vermin infestation. This subsection shall not be deemed to include items kept in covered bins or metal receptacles approved by the County Health Officer or this Code or any other ordinance of the City.

CC 21-3.b.8

Any landscaping, visible from public property, that is substantially dead, damaged, or characterized by uncontrolled growth, or presents a deteriorated appearance; uncultivated plants, weeds, tall grass, uncultivated shrubs or growth (whether growing or otherwise) higher than twelve (12) inches; or any dead trees, bushes, shrubs or portions thereof, including stumps; or any palm or similar type tree having dead or dry fronds descending downward from the base of the lowest living frond more than eight (8) feet or dry fronds longer than five (5) feet and closer than eight (8) feet to the ground.

If the violations have not been corrected within thirty days, our office will proceed with the abatement process. As owner of the property, you have thirty (30) days after receipt of this letter to abate or correct any violation as described below:

- 1. REMOVE ALL JUNK / DEBRIS FROM YOUR ENTIRE PROPERTY BACK TO FRONT.
- 2. REMOVE GRASS AND WEEDS FROM THE GRAVEL AREAS OF THE FRONT YARD LANDSCAPE.
- 3. REMOVE ALL DEAD PALM FRONDS FROM PALM TREES INCLUDING DEAD TREE LIMBS / STUMP

Upon receipt of the Hearing Officer approval to abate this public nuisance, the necessary work will be performed at the expense of the property owner. The cost of this work will be \$3,195.00. In addition to the actual cost of abatement, an administrative charge of fifteen (15) percent of the actual cost of abatement or three hundred (\$300) dollars, whichever is greater, for expenses incurred by the city for abatement procedures, and the cost of recording liens and releases will be charged. The recorded lien may bear interest at the legal rate for judgments in the State of Arizona. Administrative charges and the cost of recording liens and releases shall become a lien on the property whether or not the public nuisance is abated by the City.




