Craig Hayton introduced the newly appointed Deputy Community Services Director-Parks and Staff Liaison to the board, Alexander Jovanovic. #### Agenda Item 4 – Parks Re-Naming Update

Shereen Lerner provided an update to the board on the Parks Re-Naming from her representation on the committee on behalf of the board. Recommendations were in the packet materials and included the following:

- Michelle Brooks-Totress Park to replace Redden Park
- Parque de Sotelo-Soza to replace Hudson Park
- Mary & Moses Green Park to replace Harelson Park

The recommendations are tentatively scheduled to move forward to council in the next few weeks.

# Agenda Item 5 – Quarterly Golf Update

#### Public Private Partnership Updates

Craig Hayton provided background information on the process thus far and advised of next steps if City Council requests to move forward. Board to be notified if scheduled on Regular City Council Agenda.

- CourseCo at Ken McDonald- Three open house public meetings held on January 10, 2023. Online survey open from January 10<sup>th</sup> through February 7<sup>th</sup>. Will bring back to the board next month with information received from public comment period.
- Grass Clippings at Rolling Hills- Jake Hoselton from Grass Clippings along with other members of the staff presented to the board a PowerPoint presentation on the revised proposal. Presentation included the following:
  - Conceptual site plan
  - Conceptual site plan with existing 9
  - The golf course will be left as is, with the exception of roughly a 30 yard shift of hole 9 to allow room for the Family Activity Lawn. The golf hole will remain the same distance
  - \$13MM will be invested into upgrades of clubhouse and maintenance facilities, existing driving range, Hilltop F&B behind hole #7, and lighted golf and driving range
  - The golf course will remain open throughout the process
  - Proposed rates/structure

Board members asked questions and made comments regarding the following:

• Does the revised proposal include night golf?

- Will the wraparound windows in the clubhouse be staying?
- Will the large tree just outside the clubhouse be remaining?
- Will additional trees be planted?
- Will the course be open during renovations?
- What is the timeline for completing construction?
- Have you done things like this at other courses and was it successful?
- Is #8 tee box staying as is?
- There doesn't seem to be much room for the F&B station at the high point.
- Will there be any turf reduction?
- What are the new fees?
- Will rates go up in the future?
- Will the Loyalty Program continue?
- Are there opportunities to offer adaptive recreation golf through the City's Parks and Recreation program?
- What are the driving range rates?
- Is there an opportunity for a full-length driving range in the future?
- How does Grass Clippings plan to address erosion issues?
