Times vary depending on the school.

Weekly Office hours required. Days flexible based on availability. Other office hours vary.

Paid training multiple Saturdays in April &/or May 3-4 hours each

Permanent STEM Coordinator is available 5 days a week including early Friday release - starting wage is \$17.85 hr. Substitute STEM Coordinator is available 3 - 4 days per week only or no early release is paid slightly less.

Essential Job Functions:

Under the supervision of the Sr. Community Education Coordinator

- Develops STEM lesson plans & supply kits for site staff to check out weekly and teach on a rotational basis
- Planning, organizing and teaching a STEM instructional class for up to 20 students grades K-8 at a time.
- Develop eight to ten detailed lesson plans and teach them at sites on a rotational basis.
- Create and maintain STEM kit check-out system for sites. Work with site staff to ensure kits returned complete and in good condition.
- Order, maintain and fill supplies needed for STEM kits.
- Help train and model for site staff re: effective STEM teaching techniques
- Establish and maintain effective relationships with the children, parents, school staff and other community members.
- Maintain discipline, safety, and control of specialty class.
- Maintain an environment that promotes cooperation, learning and enjoyment.
- Encourage high participation of students in specialty class.
- Assist site manager and site staff in their implementation of a variety of recreational and educational
 activities for students and assisting in any other manner as requested.
- Assist in maintaining facility by keeping it clean, organized, and secure.
- Attend all staff meetings and trainings.

Experience and Training:

Requires experience working in an organized recreation, child care, or school program with elementary age children. Good knowledge of teaching methods and procedures including ability to plan, organize and teach STEM subject area. Must have a positive personality and child management skills. Good speaking and communication skills. Ability to work effectively with children, coworkers, and Kid Zone staff. Education in child development, recreation, education or a related field is highly desirable. Must meet AZ Dept. of Health Services Child Day Care Center Teacher-Caregiver requirements (listed on back.) Requires successful completion of required selection process, successful completion of background investigation and verification of identity and work authorization.

Table of Qualification Standards

Child Day Care Center Teacher-Caregiver (*Kid Zone Specialty Instructor*) Each teacher-cargiver shall meet ONE OF THE FOLLOWING SETS of minimum academic and qualifying experience.
