

Los Feliz Dr/Calle de Caballos Elliot to McClintock Restriping

**Neighborhood Meeting
November 17, 2022**





- Concerns received regarding speeding on Los Feliz Dr
- Speed counts taken and enforcement conducted (posted speed limit 25 mph)
 - Los Feliz Dr near Secretariat Dr
 - Northbound 85% = 35 mph (Sept 2021), 32 mph (Sept 2022)
 - Northbound speeds are at the level that could qualify for traffic calming
 - Southbound 85% = 29 mph (Sept 2021), 32 mph (Sept 2022)
 - Los Feliz Dr near Kentucky Ln
 - Northbound 85% = 26 mph (Sept 2022)
 - Southbound 85% = 28 mph (Sept 2022)

Existing Conditions

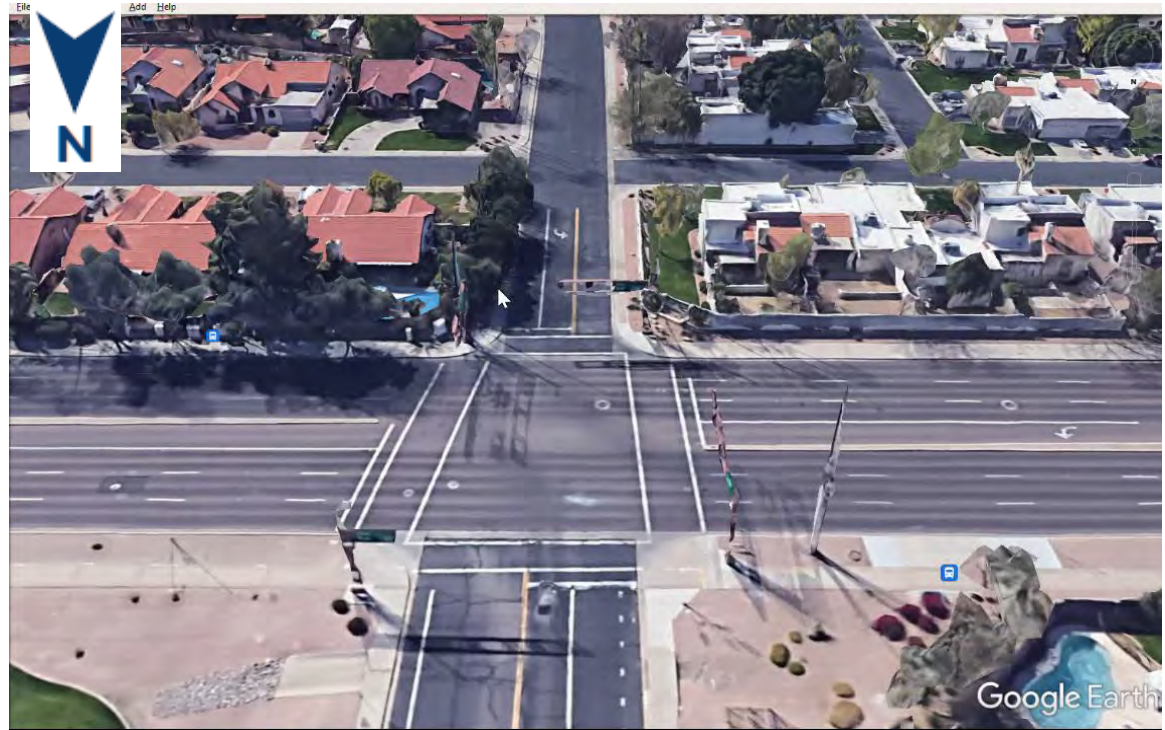
- No striping, except at:
 - Los Feliz and Elliot (signal)
 - Los Feliz and Calle de Caballos (all-way stop)
 - Calle de Caballos and McClintock (stop)

- Roadway is 40-ft wide with no lane markings
- No speed humps between Elliot Rd and Citation Ln
- Waggoner ES bus stop at Velvet Dr
- Kyrene MS bus stop at Secretariat Dr
- TUHSD bus stop at Louis Way

Existing Conditions East of McClintock Dr



- Roadway is 40-ft wide with no lane markings
- Speed humps between McClintock Dr and Citation Ln
- All-way stop at Calle de Caballos and Los Feliz Dr
- Waggoner ES bus stop at Calle de Caballos and Los Feliz Dr
- Kyrene MS bus stop at Calle de Caballos and Los Feliz Dr
- TUHSD bus stop at Calle de Caballos and Los Feliz Dr



Possible solutions to address speeding

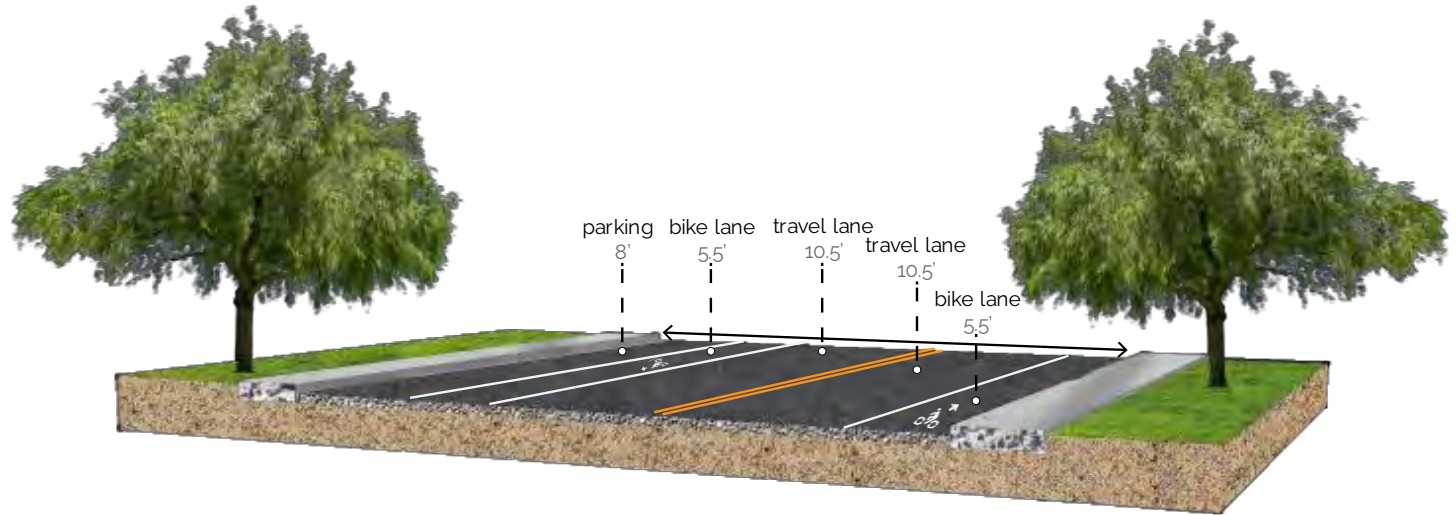


1. Stripe roadway with bike lanes and one-parking lane or sharrows
 - Visually narrows roadway
 - Can be implemented quickly
2. Install additional speed cushions between Elliot Rd and Citation Ln
 - Requires resident participation and consensus
 - Current waiting list – cannot be implemented quickly
