- Project Kick-off, Public and stakeholder outreach, UPRR negotiation, 30% design completed 2018-2020
- UPRR ROW and cost issues
- Project Scope Change (Alternative alignment 2022)
- 2022 Consultant kicks-off design for new alignment
- April 19th, 2023 Public Meetings for draft 30% designs


Realign BIKEIT Route




 Rerouting existing BIKEIT bike boulevard route on Hardy to Kyrene and Roosevelt













SEGMENT D - ROOSEVELT ST (BROADWAY RD - 13TH ST)










Kyrene Cycle Track

- Bike/ Ped Crossing








Baseline Bike/Ped Signal




