Beginner List

HB Drawing Pencil

Kneaded Eraser

Masking Tape

Liquid Frisket or Masking Fluid and (Cheap synthetic brush #3 or #4)

Rubber Cement Pick Up

12 in Ruler

Spray Bottle with fine mist

Paper Towels

Two large containers for water

(16 to 32oz plastic yogurt or slasa containers work fine)

Watercolor Paper Block:

-SoHo 9x12 Block 140 lb. Cold press (20 sheets)

Palette: white plastic with at least 12 wells, area for mixing and a cover

Watercolor Paint Tubes: (8 colors)

Recommended brands: Daniel Smith, Da Vinci, Lukas, Winsor Newton

-Ultramarine Blue,

- Prussian Blue OR Cyan Blue,

-Phthalo Turquoise,

-Lemon Yellow,

-Alizarin Crimson,

-Cadmium Red,

-Quinacridone Gold,

-Burt Umber

Watercolor Brushes: (at least 4 brushes)

(as a beginner buy medium priced brushes, if you continue with watercolor you can invest in more expensive brushes)

-One Flat Brush 1 or 1-1/2 inch

-Three Round #6, #8, #12
