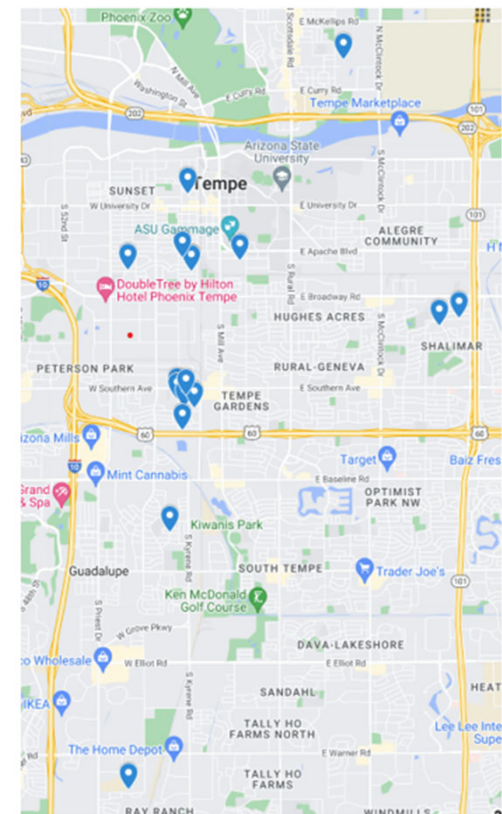

39 attendees, 31 online survey Respondents

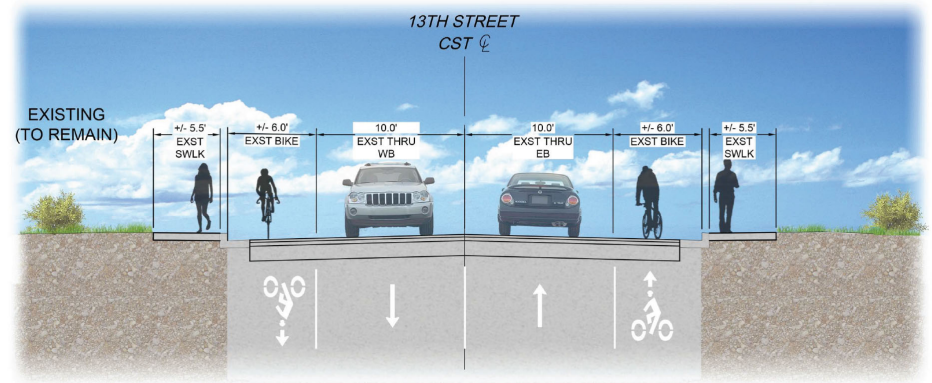
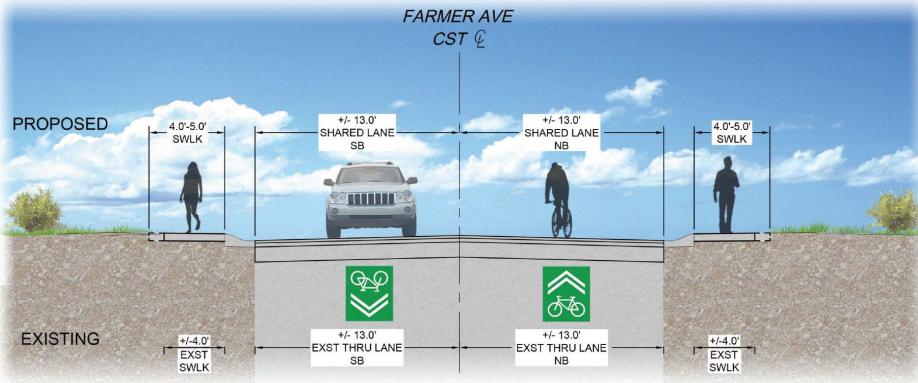
## Themes:

# Farmer Ave and 13<sup>th</sup> St.



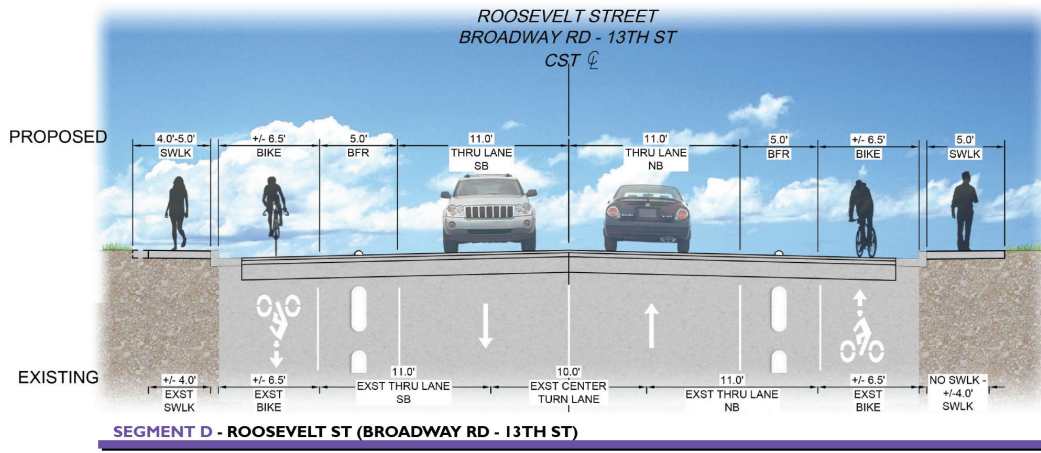
**SEGMENT D - FARMER AVE (13TH ST - UNIVERSITY DR)**

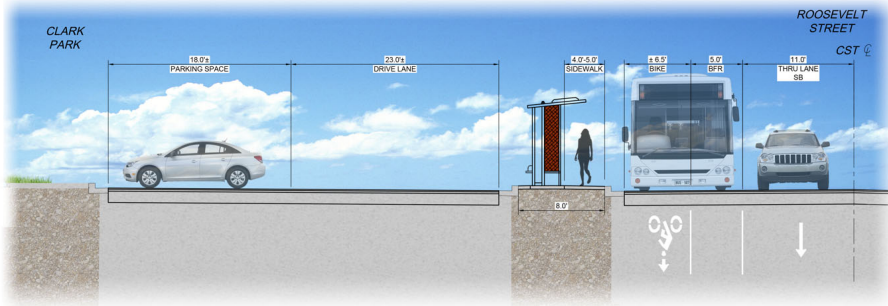
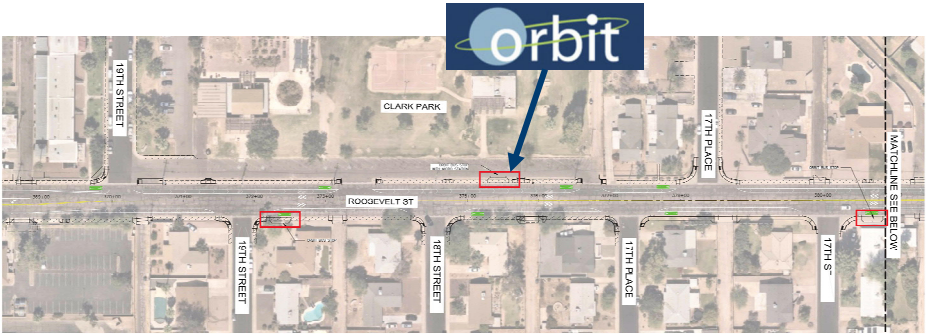
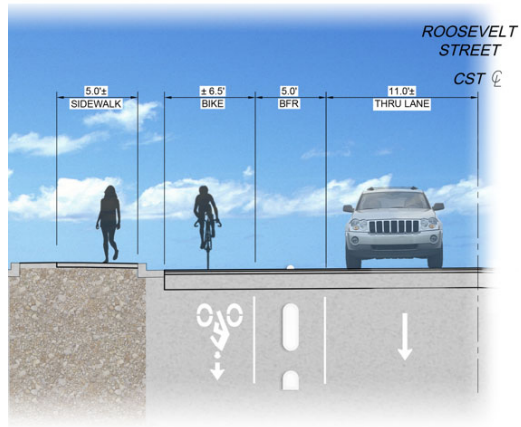
**SEGMENT D - 13TH STREET (ROOSEVELT ST - FARMER AVE)**

# Roosevelt St (13<sup>th</sup> to Broadway)

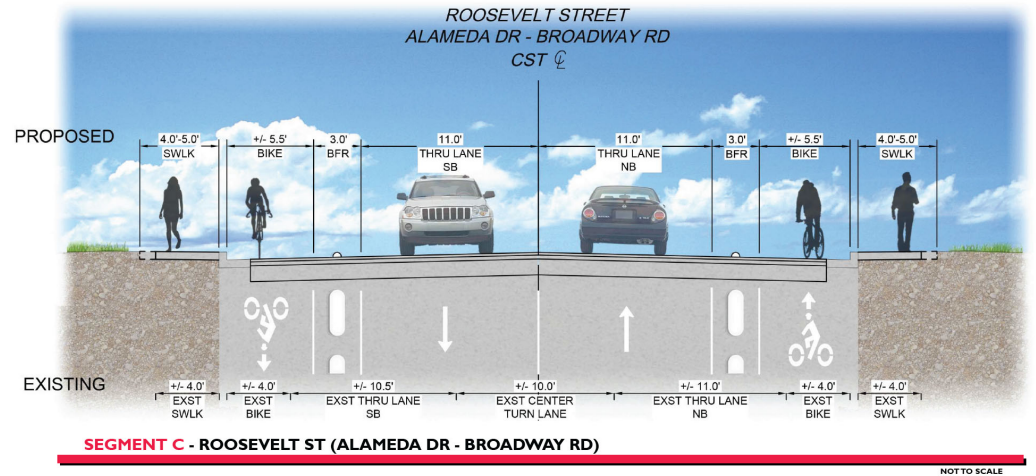


# Roosevelt St. Orbit Locations

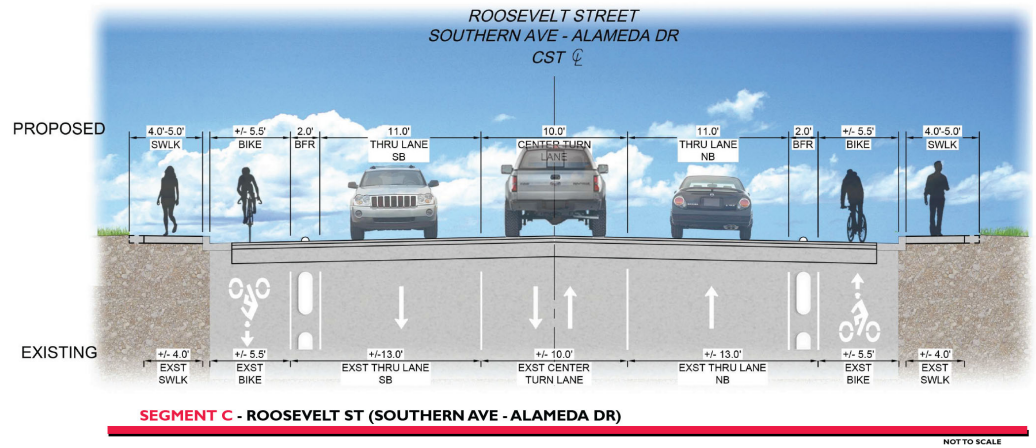

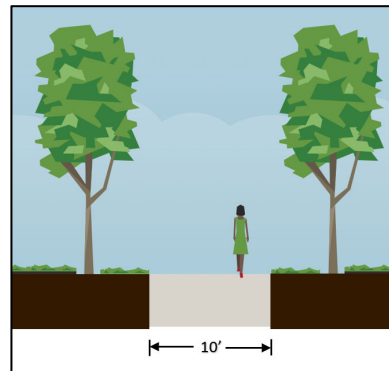

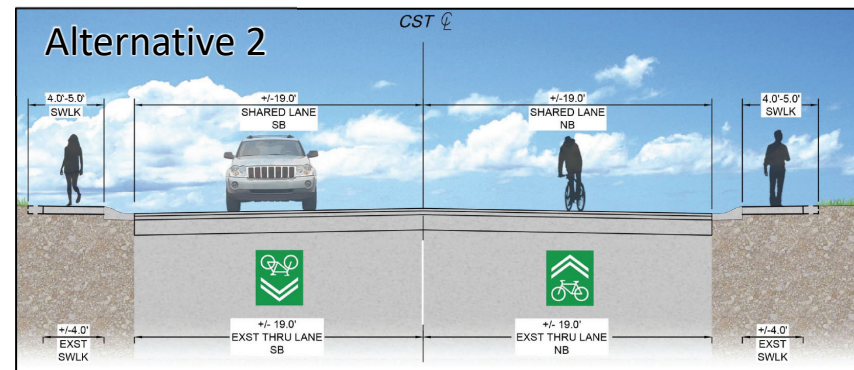

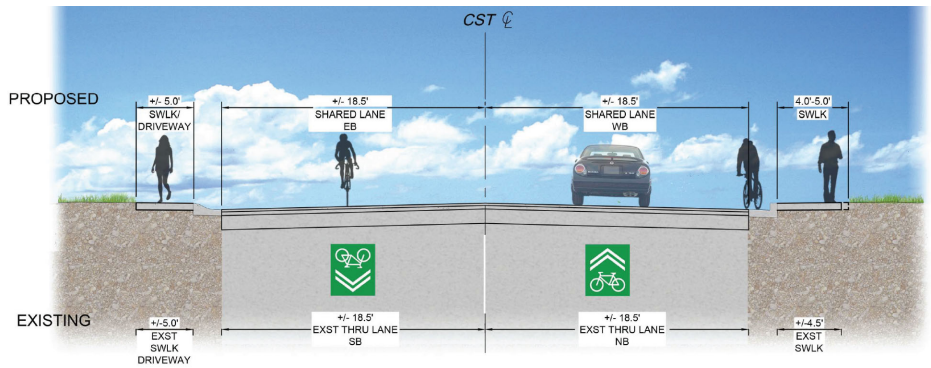

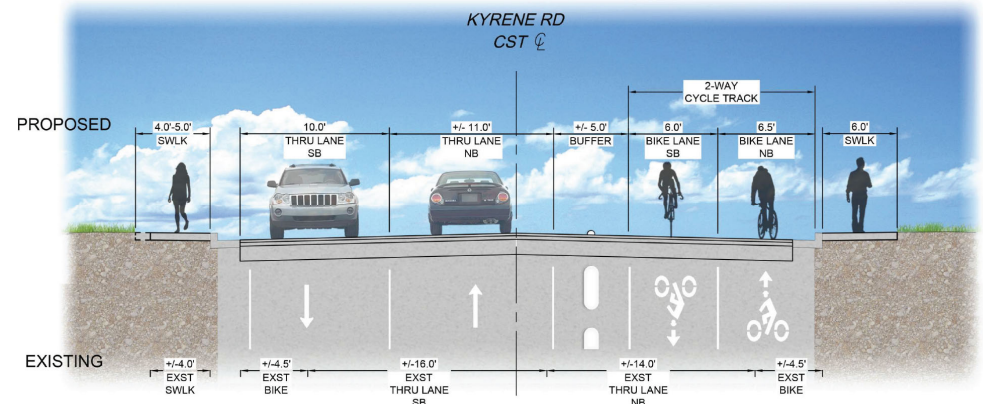

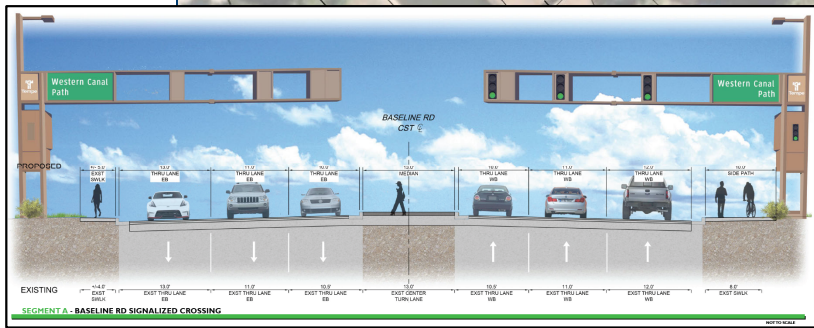
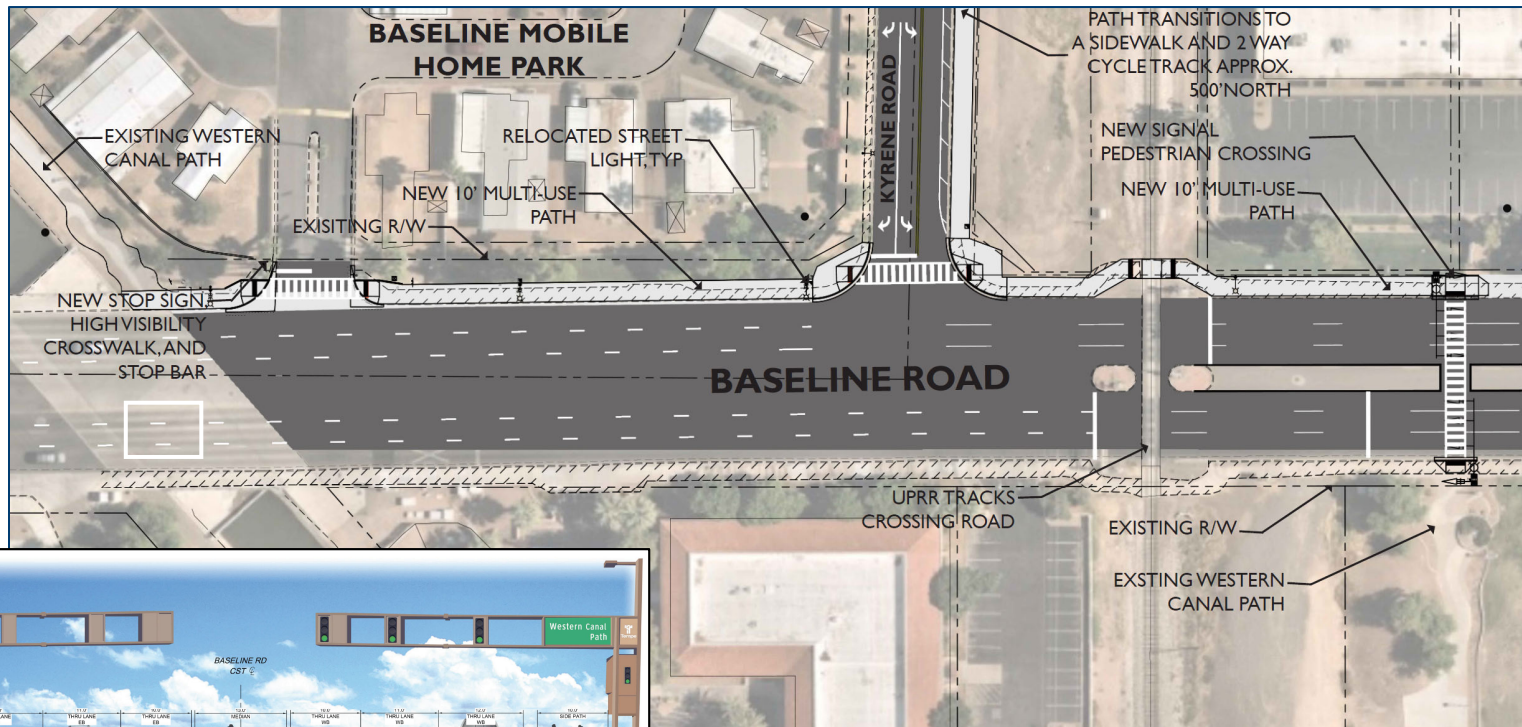
# Kyrene Cycle Track



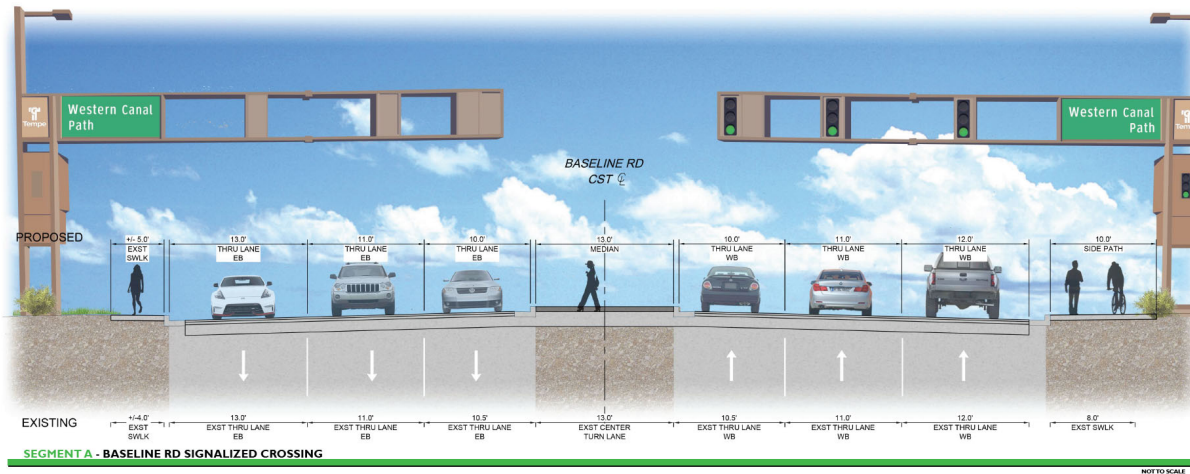
- Protected, Two-way Cycle Track on Kyrene Rd to Manhattan Dr
