




Meeting Held April 19, 2023, public comments taken from April 19th to May 2nd, 2023 39 attendees, 31 online survey Respondents

18 respondents provided an address in Tempe.






SEGMENT D - FARMER AVE (13TH ST - UNIVERSITY DR)




SEGMENT D - 13TH STREET (ROOSEVELT ST - FARMER AVE)

Roosevelt St (13th to Broadway)












Roosevelt St. Orbit Locations










Roosevelt St (Broadway to Alameda)









SEGMENT C - ROOSEVELT ST (ALAMEDA DR - BROADWAY RD)



Roosevelt St (Alameda to Southern)











Dwight Park Connection - Alt. 1






Kyrene Cycle Track

Western Canal Link from North Side






Baseline Pedestrian Signal
