Project Updates by Staff (City Council Action Items):

Ryan Levesque, Deputy Director – Community Development, advised that at the September 28th City Council meeting they heard the following projects:

- 955 East Mixed-Use project was unanimously approved. The applicant stated they are looking for window knitting to address concerns about birds hitting the glass frontage along one of the north elevations.
- Apache Square was unanimously approved. The applicant noted they are planning to make some revisions to the project based on inquires and requests. They will be adding more three-bedroom units into the project design. The revisions will require a major modification to the project so it will be coming back for a future hearing before the DRC and City Council.

- Municipal Rezoning of 1st & Farmer was unanimously approved. The applicant will need to go through the entire
 public hearing process again when they present the final development plan.
- 211 East 7th Street was postponed to the October 12th City Council hearing at the request of the applicant to prepare some revisions. They have reduced another level of parking, so it is now 27 stories with the same number of units. Commissioner Lloyd asked how many parking spaces it would now have. Mr. Levesque stated he will follow up with the actual number, but he believes it was a reduction of 40 spaces that were previously provided.
