

**RESOLUTION NO. R2023.74**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPE, ARIZONA,  
DECLARING THE OFFICIAL CANVASS OF VOTES CAST IN THE CITY OF TEMPE  
SPECIAL ELECTION HELD ON MAY 16, 2023.**

WHEREAS, a Special Election was held and conducted in the City of Tempe, Arizona, on Tuesday, May 16, 2023, for the purpose of presenting Propositions 301, 302 and 303 to the qualified electors of the City of Tempe; and,

WHEREAS, it now becomes the duty of the City Council of the City of Tempe, Arizona, to canvass the election results of the May 16, 2023, Special Election;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPE, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Exhibit A, attached, is declared and adopted as the official canvass of votes of the May 16, 2023, Special Election, and includes:

- 1) The number of ballots cast in each precinct and in the city
- 2) The number of ballots rejected in each precinct and in the city
- 3) The number and brief title of each Proposition measure
- 4) The number of votes by precincts for and against each proposed city measure.

Section 2. That, as shown in Exhibit A, the total number of ballots cast in the Special Election was 33,147.

Section 3. That the total number of votes cast in the Special Election for Proposition 301, is as follows:

32,911 total votes were cast; 14,407 votes were cast in favor of Proposition 301 and 18,504 votes were cast in opposition of Proposition 301. Proposition 301 is hereby declared to have failed and is not approved.


Section 4. That the total number of votes cast in the Special Election for Proposition 302, is as follows:

31,774 total votes were cast; 13,821 votes were cast in favor of Proposition 302 and 17,953 votes were cast in opposition of Proposition 302. Proposition 302 is hereby declared to have failed and is not approved.

Section 5. That the total number of votes cast in the Special Election for Proposition 303, is as follows:

31,866 total votes were cast; 13,570 votes were cast in favor of Proposition 303 and 18,296 votes were cast in opposition of Proposition 303. Proposition 303 is hereby declared to have failed and is not approved.




