Agenda Item 4 – Golf Update

CourseCo

- Tom Bugbee, Troy Thompson, and Desiree Sloat presented an update on CourseCo, Ken McDonald golf course and first 100 days.
 - Based in northern California
 - Retained over 90% of original staff already working at the course
 - Incorporating proprietary staff training called SWEAT (smile, welcome, enthusiasm, ask, thank you)
 - Have gotten first of two cart fleets: 8-16 months out for delivery of carts from order date
 - Marketing: new website, new social media, new POS, new course reputation management through Yelp
 - Golf course enhancements: new golf course Superintendent, improved irrigation efficiency, new equipment acquisitions
 - Overseeding
 - Community outreach: continued support of local clubs, league play, continued hosting of Tempe Parks & Rec activities, continued hosting of local school golf programs, developing 2024 events calendar, first non-golf community event scheduled for December 16, Swings With Santa
 - Board members asked questions and made comments about:
 - o What is status with well drilling and piping?
 - o Are they recharge wells?

Ken McDonald Clubhouse RFQ

- Julie Hietter provided an update on Ken McDonald Clubhouse RFQ.
 - City wanted to find private sector partner to help development
 - Master Plan of site has been initiated
 - Timeline:
 - RFQ to find consultant to help with Master Plan process; Jan May
 - o Design
 - Construction ETA 2026
 - Preliminary meeting with YMCA
 - Board members asked questions and made comments about:
 - Relocation of clubhouse temporarily and will it happen multiple times?
 - o What is the use level of golf course currently?
 - o Will there be access to information about use of golf course?
 - o Has Fred Wood been updated?

Agenda Item 5 - Tempe Town Lake On-Water RFP

Craig Hayton presented information about updates to Rio Salado Master Plan.

- Rio Salado Master Plan was designed to ensure Rio Salado area, Tempe Town Lake, park and preserve space is point of pride for next 30 years.
- Balance area as event destination and use of space
- Passive and active opportunities, sustainability, add shade, programmatic opportunities
- 10 distinct use areas, 3 highlighted as underdeveloped comparatively
- Funding opportunities: public and private

- October 2023 RFP for passive, concession-based recreation on Tempe Town Lake
- January 2024 RFQ to develop conceptual master plan for three activity zones
- Early 2025 RFP for land, aerial, and water-based recreational opportunities
- Board members asked questions and made comments about:
 - o Have there been discussions to install lights on volleyball courts?
 - o How much more commercial development is expected?
 - o Could there be conflict between the RFPs and RFQ?
 - o Why were RFPs and RFQ separated into three individual processes?

Agenda Item 6 – Tempe Historic Preservation Foundation Cemetery Study – Logan Simpson

Wayne Colebank from Logan Simpson presented on Tempe Historic Preservation Foundation's Double Butte cemetery study and needs assessment.

- Possibility of coordinating a site visit for board
- Focus of study was Pioneer section
- West side of cemetery has grass and trees, east side is desert; Pioneer section is in desert
- Overall cemetery 17 acres, Pioneer section a little under 2 acres
- Drainage goes north to south
- At least 50 grave markers in need of repair or replacement; represents at least 1/3 of grave markers
- Grave plot borders degraded, Foundation would like to have addressed
- Other areas of concern identified: ground surface treatments, wooden features, settlement, sink holes, pests, fences, trees, shrubs, pavement edges, flood irrigation
- Character defining features need to be addressed to preserve historical setting
- Developed Landscape Master Plan to cover entire cemetery
- Who is responsible for addressing identified areas of concern?
- Recommendation to hire consultant
- Board members asked questions and made comments about:
 - Are the changes being identified just for Pioneer section?
 - O What is the City's perspective on who is responsible?
 - What responsibility does City have to property it owns?
 - o Are there living descendants who are connected to the cemetery plots?
 - o December 9 installation ceremony for Tempe African American Pioneers Cemetery
