TEMPE YOUTH FREE TRANSIT PASS PROGRAM POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

Tempe's transportation program, Tempe in Motion, offers a free transit pass for youth ages 6 to 18 who live in Tempe or Guadalupe through the Youth Free Transit Pass Program. The Tempe youth transit pass is valid on all Valley Metro bus routes and the light rail. Through the program, youth can receive a free annual transit pass valued at \$384. The passes are valid for one year, from June 1 to June 30.

What is required to get the pass if under the age of 18?

- A parent or guardian must accompany the youth when registering for the program.
- A paper copy of a utility bill (dated within the last 60 days) with a Tempe address. Acceptable utility bills include SRP, APS, Southwest Gas, City of Tempe, Cox Communications, Century Link, Direct TV, Dish Network, cell phone company, bank statement, or a current statement from the Department of Economic Security (DES). The bill must have the youth's parent or guardian's name. Lease agreements are not acceptable forms of proof of residency.
- Youth's birth certificate (the accompanying parent must be listed as the birth parent on the certificate).
- A valid driver's license/photo ID of parent/guardian.
- If you are the step parent or legal guardian you must also bring a copy of your marriage license or state guardianship papers. Notarized guardianship papers are not acceptable proof of guardianship.

What is required to get the pass if age 18?

- A valid driver's license, ID card or US passport.
- A paper copy of a utility bill (dated within the last 60 days) with a Tempe address. Acceptable utility bills include; SRP, APS, Southwest Gas, City of Tempe, Cox Communications, Century Link, Direct TV, Dish Network, cell phone company, bank statement, or current statement from the Department of Economic Security (DES). Lease agreements are not acceptable forms of proof of residency.
- An 18 year old who lives at home with a parent or guardian may use the parent or guardian's utility bill as proof of address <u>if they bring a birth certificate</u> with the parent or guardian name listed on the birth certificate. This provides proof that the name listed on the utility bill is the parent or guardian.

Replacement of a non-expired pass:

- Participants are allowed (3) three replacement passes per year (June to July) for lost, stolen or damaged passes.
- For a replacement pass, either the parent OR child can visit the Transit Store to pay the \$5 fee. Both do not have to come.
- No documentation is necessary.
