QUALIFICATIONS

- Will complete 7th grade by June 2024 (some exceptions allowed)
- Interested in working with children and the public in an active environment
- Have a positive attitude and the ability to work with a team
- Have leadership skills or want to develop them
- Can pay attention to instructions and follow them with minimal supervision

REQUIREMENTS

- Attend the Museum Volunteer Orientation on Tuesday, May 28, 10 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.
 Orientation counts as volunteer hours, and the museum will provide lunch
- Volunteer for at least 5 of the 7 Wednesday program sessions
- Report on time and stay until the end of the shift
- Focus on visitors and tasks throughout the event--put cell phones away during shifts
