

MATCHLINE - SEE ABOVE RIGHT 4th Street






### Mill Avenue Refresh Project Purpose



- Infrastructure upgrades (electrical, irrigation etc.)
  - Re-fresh from 1980's original streetscape
- Sidewalks, ramps & ADA improvements
- Tree canopy & plants (heat & drought tolerant species/sustainability focus)
  - Retain healthy existing ficus & have a replacement tree identified
- Enhanced pedestrian & public space
- Celebrate history & culture

### What to Expect



- Current work at the intersection of Mill Ave. and University Dr. is generally done during daytime and weekdays
- Some restrictive operations will be performed during off-peak hours
- Additional off-peak work will be added when work starts on Mill Ave. north of University
- Barricades will remain in place 24/7 for safety and work zone protection
  - Bicycle lane and on-street parking will be closed only in the area where work is occuring
  - Delivery and loading zones will be accommodated

## What to Expect



- Roads will generally remain open for travel
- Limited weekend closure for intersection work
- Accommodate planned downtown events
- Maintenance of access:
  - Business access will be maintained
  - Pedestrian access will be maintained
  - Public transit / Streetcar will be maintained



#### Schedule



- Construction began April 2024
- Work started at the intersection of Mill Ave. and University Dr.
- Work to tentatively start in July on Mill Ave., will know more end of May
- Intention to work block by block
- Completion date TBD
