Project Updates by Staff (City Council Action Items):

Ryan Levesque, Deputy Director, Community Development – Planning, advised the Commission that at the City Council's May 11, 2024 meeting they heard the following:

The City Council heard a request from Creative Environments, which is a 4,000 square foot welding shop addition located at 8949 South Beck Avenue. This site is in the General Industrial Overlay District, where the development expansion is adjacent to single-family zoning and industrial areas. Mr. Levesque stated that there is an automatic requirement where this type of project goes directly to the City Council where they are basically approving design review through a public hearing process where property owners are notified of the request. Mr. Levesque stated that no members of the public came about this item. He advised that both the Use Permit and Development Plan Review were approved by the City Council. Mr. Levesque stated that this is only the second time that the City has had to use the General Industrial Overlay District zoning overlay.
