### **COMMUNITY ARTS GRANTS AWARDEES**

This week, the City of Tempe awarded 27 arts grants to nonprofit organizations and artist collectives that will support the presentation of inclusive arts and culture programs in Tempe. Community Arts grant funding fulfills the objective of the Arts and Culture Plan to invest \$300,000 per year to support artists and organizations and advance goals to ignite creative vibrancy, help build capacity, and grow community connections.

In this first round, a total of 27 grant applications were received and all grants were awarded for funding that totals \$187,000. Currently, \$113,000 remains towards grant funds for two categories with deadlines this fall: Arts in Schools and cycle two of the Vibrant City Art Grant.

The funding allocation process involved four independent community review panels comprised of representatives from the Tempe Arts and Culture Commission, African American Advisory Committee, Career Ready Tempe student, Tempe Tourism, Tempe residents, arts educators, students and practicing artists. Panels include diversity of ethnicity, gender, artistry and age.

Projects will be presented in theaters, community centers, parking lots and other surprising spaces across the city. Here are this year's grant recipients:
