## Agenda Item 3 - Approval of Minutes: May 6, 2024

## Agenda Item 4 – Scooter Program + Sidewalk Accessibility Concerns: Eric Iwersen

Staff member Eric Iwersen gave background on the scooter program origins, and how it has evolved.

Commissioner Gomez and Commissioner Bunch asked about the expansion of the scooter corrals. Eric let the commissioners know they are working to expand this and working on the framework of the scooter company relationships.

Commissioner Kader asked for the repercussions for the scooter companies as well as the scooter operators for not placing the scooters in the proper corral. Eric responded that this process is still under review. He will pass along information as it becomes available.

Commissioner Tokos gave guidance on additional oversight for scooter placement to help mitigate impacts on the community. Eric will bring this back to the team and see if this capability is there.

Commissioner Vega offered for the CDC to speak on behalf of the community and advocate for additional protections and proper education on the impact on improperly placed scooters.

Chair Jefferson thanked Eric for his time, and the Commission for their engagement.
