
1. Official Convass of the City of Tempe Primary/Special Election, March 22, 1988.

PRIMARY/SPECIAL ELECTION OF MARCH 22, 1988
CITY OF TEMPE, ARIZONA

We, the undersigned, comprising the City Council of the City of Tempe, Arizona do hereby certify that a Primary/Special Election was held in the City of Tempe on Tuesday, March 22, 1988, for the nomination of candidates to be voted for at the General Election to be held in said City of Tempe on the 10th day of May, 1988, for the election of Mayor for a term of two years, and for the election of three Councilmen for a term of four years each, to begin on the first regular meeting in July, 1986 and for authorization to levy and collect an additional transaction privilege tax of two percent (2%) of the gross income from rentals on transient occupancy/bed and lodging (30 days or less) in addition to the one percent (1%) tax currently levied and collected.

WE FURTHER CERTIFY that the Poll Lists and Certificates of Inspection and Tally Sheets of said Primary Election were duly filed in our office within three (3) hours after said election and that we met in accordance with the law on Thursday, March 31, 1988 and commenced canvassing the returns of said Election, as attached:

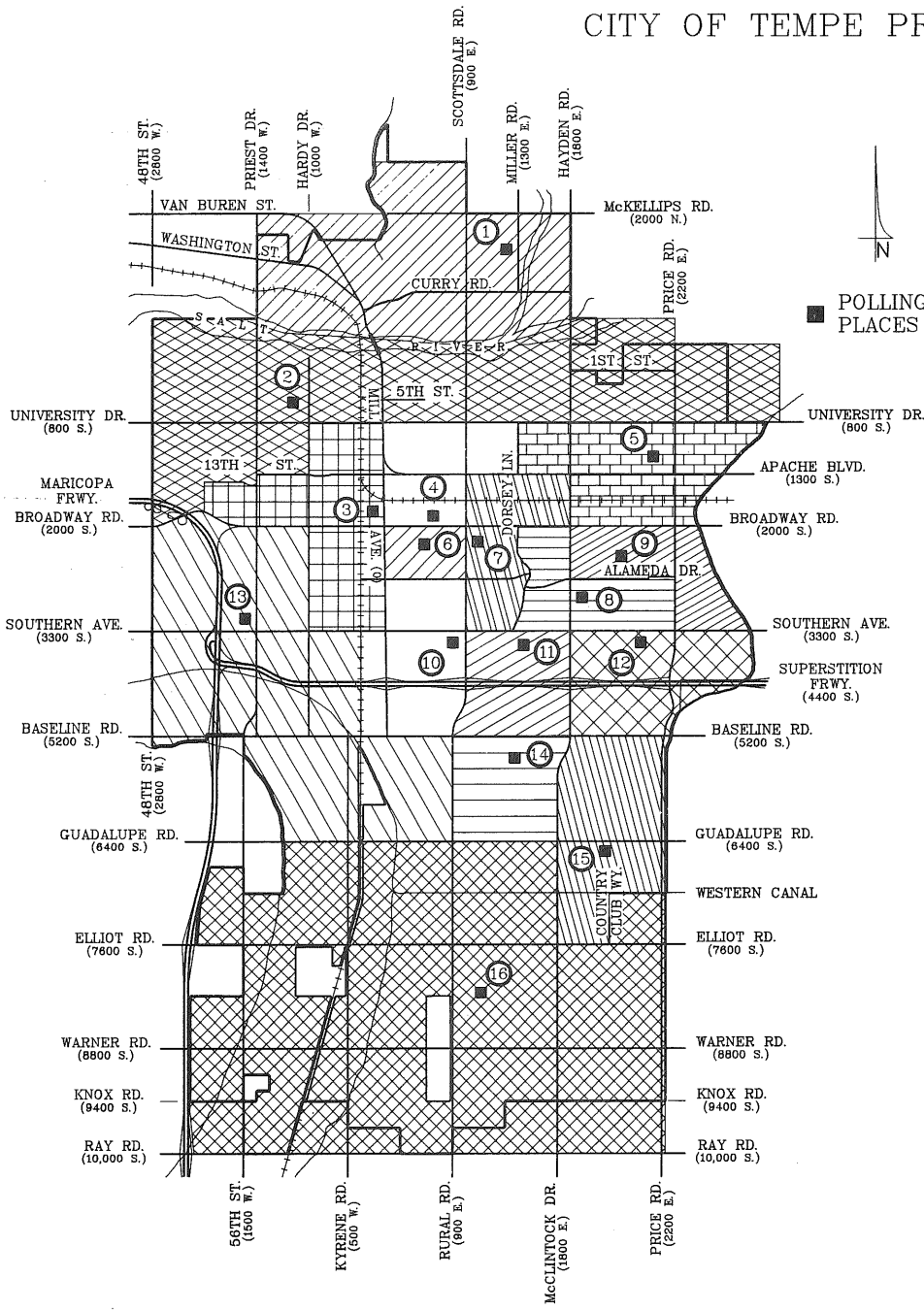




