The 1990 General Election was held on May 8, 1990. There were 18 voting districts and one absentee district. Logic and Accurancy tests were performed before, during and after the ballot counting.

The ballot tally began at 8:02 p.m. and the last district totals came off at 8:48 p.m.

We are pleased to announce that the following named persons, having received the highest number of votes cast, were elected to the office of Councilman:

All newly elected officials will be sworn in and take office at the first regular Council meeting in July.

Attached are the computer printouts of the vote tally for each district, plus the final summary report. The final total voter turnout was 7475 or 10.2% of the total registered voters. Maricopa County verified 32 questioned ballots; 17 of them counted, 13 were rejected for various reasons; three absentee questioned ballots were rejected; increasing the total ballots cast from 7458 to 7475.




