RESOLUTION NO. 2012.36

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPE, ARIZONA, DECLARING AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS OF THE MARCH 13, 2012 PRIMARY ELECTION

WHEREAS, a Primary Election was held and conducted in the City of Tempe, Arizona, on Tuesday, March 13, 2012, for the purpose of nominating and/or electing candidates for the position of Mayor and three City Council seats; and,

WHEREAS, it now becomes the duty of the City Council of the City of Tempe, Arizona to canvass and declare the results of the March 13, 2012 Primary Election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPE, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the number of votes cast at each precinct and the number of votes cast for each candidate is listed in Exhibit A, which is hereby declared and adopted as the official canvass.

Section 2. That the total number of ballots cast in the Primary Election was 20,160.

<u>Section 3.</u> That the names of the candidates voted for at the Primary Election for the office of Mayor are:

Mark Mitchell Michael Monti Linda Spears

<u>Section 4.</u> That no candidate received a majority of the ballots cast for the office of Mayor and that Mark Mitchell and Michael Monti, who equal no more than twice the number of candidates for the office of Mayor and who received the highest number of votes, shall be the candidates for Mayor and have their names placed on the official ballot at the May 15, 2012 General Election.

<u>Section 5.</u> That the names of the candidates voted for at the Primary Election for the office of City Councilmember are:

Dick Foreman Kolby Granville Joel Navarro Angie Taylor Thornton Corey Woods GC Saarup (write-in candidate)

<u>Section 6.</u> That Joel Navarro and Corey Woods received a majority of the ballots cast in the Primary Election and are elected to the office of City Councilmember, as of the May 15, 2012 General Election and are hereby issued certificates of election.

<u>Section 7.</u> That there being one City Council seat left to be filled at the General Election, Dick Foreman and Kolby Granville, who equal no more than twice the number of candidates for the City Council seat to be filled and who received the highest number of votes, shall be candidates for City Councilmember and have their names placed on the official ballot at the May 15, 2012 General Election.

<u>Section 8.</u> That the City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City of Tempe a statement, known and designated as the official canvass, which shall include:
