

Board of Adjustment

The Board of Adjustment hears and decides variance applications; appeals from decisions made by the Hearing Officer, pertaining to variances and abatements; and appeals from any decision made by the Zoning Administrator. The Board consists of seven members and two alternates. Each member must be a Tempe resident. Alternate members serve at the Board hearing whenever a regular Board member is unable to attend or must decline due to conflict of interest. The terms are for three years. (Arizona Revised Statutes §9-462.06; Zoning and Development Code, Part 1, Chapter 3, Section 1-306)
