- 1. Make sure your permit was issued AFTER June 30, 2007
- 2. Make sure your residence is over 20-years old
- 3. Make sure your project receives a FINAL inspection approval within one-year of permit issuance

- 5. Submit your rebate application by fax, mail or in person
- 6. Allow 4 to 6 weeks for processing

Building Safety Division Residential Building Improvement Program



The Program

The program provides a 100% rebate for all building safety fees on projects completed on existing single family residential properties that are



over 20-years old in the City of Tempe.

Projects that are complete

and receive a final building inspection approval within one-year from the issuance of a building permit will qualify.

This includes all residential additions, alterations and home projects normally reviewed and permitted by the Building Safety Division.

Eligible Projects Include

Room additions*

Building alterations

Patio Covers

In-ground Pools

Landscape Work

Plumbing, Electrical & Mechanical alterations

And other qualifying projects!
