EPA has proposed the first comprehensive national system for reporting emissions of carbon dioxide and other greenhouse gases produced by major sources in the United States.

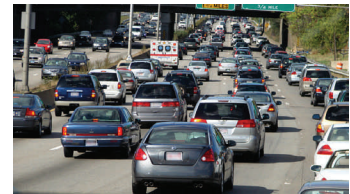

ADEQ Draft for Industrial Multi-Sector General Permit for Stormwater



The multi-sector general permit (MSGP) is designed for discharges of stormwater from certain industrial sites that are of a non-construction nature. The MSGP is one large permit divided into numerous separate sectors. Each sector represents a different type of activity and is dependent upon its standard industrial classification (SIC) code or narrative description.

The City of Tempe made modifications to the sewer use ordinance which included issuance of a general permit by rule for non-domestic users of the sanitary sewer system.
