• **K. Nelson** explained that a statue of former Arizona senator Barry Goldwater was dedicated in the National Statuary Hall at the U.S. Capitol in Washington on Wednesday, Feb. 11, 2015. Deborah Copenhaver-Fellows was selected to create the statue.

Agenda Item 5 - Discovery Business Campus, Art in Private Development

- Matt Brucker and Jim Wentworth presented artist Ilan Averbuch's design plans for the Phase I art element to be installed at Discovery Business Campus, a 135 acre mixeduse office park at Elliot Road and Price Road:
 - -design is a subtle interpretation of an anchor
 - -sculpture to include lighting and possible water feature
 - -a plaque referencing the artist and project will be included
 - -artist plans to incorporate upcycled materials, such as granite from old roads
- TMAC members comments:
 - 1) Reconsider water feature, possibly use glass or other materials to represent water
 - 2) Consider a seating wall for employees and visitors to sit and appreciate the art
 - 3) Consider levitating the sculpture to provide a better view that would otherwise be obstructed within a parking lot full of cars
- Discovery Business Campus will return to TMAC for review of the Phase II art element.
