- Lauren Lee, artist, presented her proposal for the mural wall at Jaycee Park facing Hardy Drive. The mural, titled "Don't Wake the Dreamer," includes depictions of a sleeping woman covered in flowers, a constellation filled sky, and renditions of the "Three Birds" from her Roosevelt Row mural.
