# **Support for Arts and Arts Organizations**

- -3.1: Double its Arts Grants funding to \$300,000
- -3.7: Reinstate the full percent for art requirement on city capital improvement projects
- -3.8: Increase the City's required public art allocation to 2%
- -3.10: Eliminate the local artist preference from the public art program
- -3.12:Involve artists early in the design process of city capital and private development projects

#### **Diversity and Inclusion**

- -4.1: Increase diversity among members of the Tempe Arts and Culture Commission (Currently named Tempe Municipal Arts Commission)
- -4.2: Create a diversity and inclusion subcommittee of the Tempe Arts and Culture Commission

- -5.12: Reinstate ability of the Commission to form subcommittees
