

Subject: Tax Revenue Statistical Report – June 2015

Attached is the Executive Summary of the Tax Revenue Statistical Report for June 2015 covering May sales activity reported to our Tax and License Division in June.


The graph to the right depicts year-to-date General Fund historical privilege tax revenue from FY 2005-06 through FY 2014-15. While taxable sales increased by 10.0% over last fiscal year, General Fund Sales Tax revenue collected for FY 2014-15 is down 2.7% as a result of the expiration of the temporary tax. In terms of actual dollars received (\$86.4 million), we are \$2.4 million below last fiscal year (\$88.8 million). The leading category of growth in terms of dollars received was Contracting, which grew by 56.1%. This is consistent with our February 2015



forecast for FY 2014-15 (\$85.5 million), which is significantly stronger than initial budget estimates.

The graph below represents twelve months of activity, comparing current year General Fund monthly sales tax collections to the previous year. Current and previous years' collections are broken into two components: the 1.2% permanent tax and the expired 0.2% temporary tax.

Although sales taxes are not budgeted on a monthly basis, the graph below applies historical collection percentages to the annual budget to gain insight into sales tax performance. Using this approach, sales tax collections in the General Fund are \$228 thousand above budgeted projections for the month.
