Agenda Item 1 - Call Meeting To Order/Introductions

Agenda Item 2 - Consideration of the Meeting Minutes: August 11, 2015

 - 2. MY LIFE presenters will give their personal stories for 15-20 minutes total (3 minutes per person).
 - 3. MYAC will use information from our past meetings with MY LIFE as prompters for discussions with the groups (i.e.: Buddy system for new students, transportation for Foster care kids, greater communication between school districts so Foster care kids can transfer credits, trauma awareness training for teachers, etc.).

Agenda Item 4 - Presentation Practice

Alexis lead the group to discuss the specific details of the presentation. The group discussed their personal reasons for wanting to present about Foster Care to the Superintendent's Student Advisory Board (SSAC). The group decided that they will use the following speaking points in their introductory presentation:

- 1. They will state their names.
- 2. Describe MYAC: MYAC are representatives and advocates for their peers in Tempe. They are a voice for youth and they speak directly to the City Mayor, Council, and High School Board. Their goals are to identify and solve problems that affect youth in our community.
- 3. They are presenting to SSAC about Foster Care because this is an issue that affects more students that people are aware of. They have heard personal stories, have friends who are in foster care, and want to raise greater awareness about the challenges Foster Care youth face so that students and schools can change the culture in schools to better support youth in Foster Care.
