University Drive Streetscape Project Public Meeting Notes – Sheet 3 – January 2012

Project Intent and Location

Improve pedestrian and bicycle facilities, enhance the streetscape and calm traffic on University Drive between the Union Pacific Railroad Line (east of Farmer Avenue) and Priest Drive. Recharacterize the street as a stronger multi-modal, sustainable corridor with access for all types of users and is a complement to the adjacent businesses and neighborhoods.

Attendee Notes:

- Art monument (in the middle of S. Priest Drive and University)
- Bus pull-out (on University at Priest)
- Diagram of road cross-section = cone, asphalt, median, asphalt cone
- Added trees near S Margo Drive
- Remove crosswalks at S. Beck Avenue
- Take out asphalt and add landscaping and pavers in median
- This is a good sidewalk example (near S Beck Avenue)
- Median with trees/scrubs between S Beck Avenue and S Hardy Drive
- Specialty paving to break up length of street visually
- Celebrate intersection "paving pattern" (at S. Hardy Drive)
- Larger crossing corners pedestrians/bikes (at S. Hardy Drive)
- Added landscape between Hardy and Beck
- Slow down traffic by making east/west lights turn red more often!
- More outreach with ASU art students for public art (free contractors!)
- Bike sensor (like at Hardy)
- Add pedestrian crossings at S. Roosevelt
- Business access (near Roosevelt)
- Roosevelt = center between Hardy and ASU
- Median with plantings (between Mitchell and Farmer)
- Bike sensors (at Farmer)
- Trees on sides of University between Farmer and Ash
- Community Garden (at corner of Farmer and University)
- Grocery Store? (currently Trader Joes to be Whole Foods)
