# Agenda Item 5 - MYAC & Kid Zone Garden Event Planning

**Ryan Emerson**, **MYAC Community Service Project Chair** lead a discussion to determine the details of how MYAC will teach Kid Zone children about the C.I.T.Y. Community Garden.

- The MYAC members will teach the Kid Zone children about recycling and gardening for a "sustainability" theme. The project will be called the "Lead 'n Seed Initiative."
- **Lily** will schedule Dawn Ratcliffe to teach the MYAC members about recycling in the City of Tempe for the April 19<sup>th</sup> MYAC meeting.
- The MYAC students will bring upcycled Styrofoam blocks from EF Block LLC so the students can put handprints in plaster and the blocks will then be used to build a raised garden bed for the C.I.T.Y. Community Garden.
- MYAC will also make "seed bombs" with the Kid Zone students and then have a distance throwing contest to see how far the kids can throw their seeds to grow.
- They will work with 40-50 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade students.
- MYAC will go to a Kid Zone site on April 26<sup>th</sup> at 4pm to present this project.
- Lily will determine which Kid Zone site MYAC will visit based upon the Kid Zone's staff preferences.
