Maryanne Corder Grant Program

Our HOA is looking at the Maryanne Corder Grant Program again in 2016. This fund provides a matching grant (up to \$10,000) for enhancement of our community. The Board is currently looking at bids and design criteria for xeriscaping (desert landscaping) the sections of grass that run along Mill Avenue between the sidewalk and the street. In these "border" areas alone we have close to 11,500 square feet of grass which can be converted. We will use low water plants, trees, and shrubs, on separate low-use watering systems, to keep these areas attractive while lowering maintenance and water usage. We hope to get this done in one year, but may need to split this project across two years if we cannot get a quality job done within the budget we have set aside.


About the Maryanne Corder Program

Tempe Gardens HOA is located both North and South of US 60 along the East side of Mill Avenue, in Tempe. We are a condominium complex of 169 townhouse (2-story) units. (There is no mailing address for the complex, but my address (in the middle of the North side) is 16 E Hermosa Drive, Tempe, AZ 85282.)

Tempe Gardens HOA is preparing to xeriscape our landscape (turf) between the Sidewalk and Mill Ave.

On the North side we have approx: 200 linear ft of 5' wide turf, and 465 linear ft of 12' wide turf.

On the South side we have approx: 220 linear ft of 5' wide turf, and 275 linear ft of 12' wide turf

Approx: 11,500sq ft. total.

There is irrigation to the area now, but it serves sprinklers on both sides of the sidewalk. There will have to be some irrigation plumbing and re design as part of the project.

I am asking you to bid the project using the plant guidelines below (all low water plants): AND-Because we might need to break the job in half, and only do one side this year and the other side next year depending on budget considerations, we will want separate bids for North of US60 and South of the 60.

Madison Gold is probably the most economical gravel to use, and that works for us.

All plants/trees should be bid to be in 5gal size (no staking for trees). Planting will be in small groups – some around trees, and some in a color grouping without a tree. This will consolidate the irrigation needs to specific areas where the plant group is located and will accommodate the water needs for the tree in groups with a tree. Thank you for your bid on our Xeriscape project along Mill Ave.

In response to your uncertainty about what we wanted in plants-with no design plan--, I encouraged you to be creative. Unfortunately that creativity made for very unequal bids, and gave us serious budget concerns. I now have some better design guidelines that will help us get bids for equal expectations with respect to design and plants desired.

I am asking you to re-bid the project using the plant guidelines below (all low water plants): Because we might need to break the job in half, and only do one side this year and the other side next year. We will want separate bids for North of US60 and South of the 60.

Madison Gold is probably the most economical gravel to use, and that works for us.



Tempe Gardens HOA Xeriscape Project March 2016

Summary of Bids:

URW (Travis Smith)

Full project (both North and South): 41,790 + plants. (I asked for a re-bid based on specs developed after his bid, but he hasn't had the time to provide it.)

Think Green (Eddie)

Full project (both North and South): 82,915.69 (When I asked for a re-bid to our specs developed later, they said that if cost was an issue, they would decline to bid.

Greenparti (Our HOA landscapers)

Full project: 20,600

They originally bid the project without irrigation or plants for 7,800, with plants and irrigation they quoted 2,200 for each side.

When asked to re-bid to the new specs, the bid was 6,640.00 for the North, and 6,160 for the South. After the 7,800 for turf removal etc. from their original bid, the total comes to 20,600. (Their bid includes 5gal and 15 gal sizes instead of the 1gal size called for.)

Native Landscaping LLC (Miguel Delgado)

They bid only the North side 25,130, but if South side is the same, the total would be 50,260. (They did not follow specs and bid 5gal plants instead of the 1gal size in the specs.)

Creative Environments (Amy or Sheldon)

They bid 38, 004.17 for the North side and 25,780.10 for the South, Total 63784.27 This is not a firm bid (Budgitary-not for contract). They bid 5gal sizes not 1gal as specified.

It is possible that the actual price from each will be adjusted when the actual plants needed are adjusted to the areas, and the size specs.

Due to budget considerations, the HOA may only do one side this year, and do the other next year. Getting the grant will be a major consideration it determining what we are able to do.
