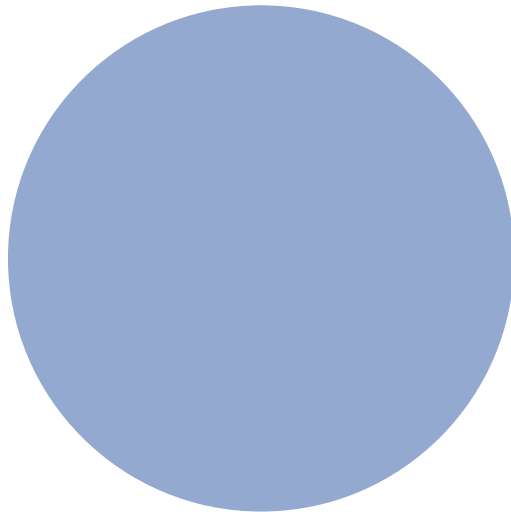




Meyer Park Improvements Meeting + Online Survey Results March 24 – April 7, 2016

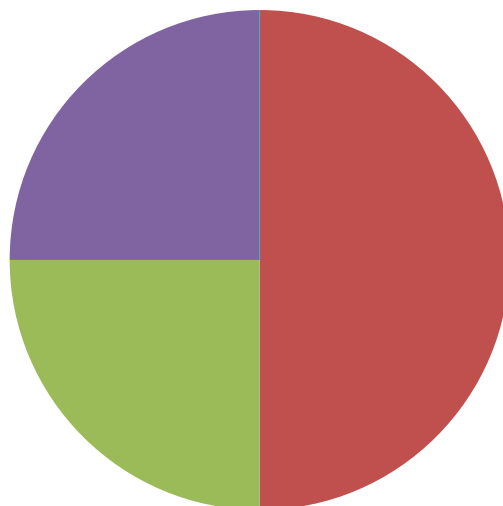
1. Pathway located between the playground and volleyball court (red line)

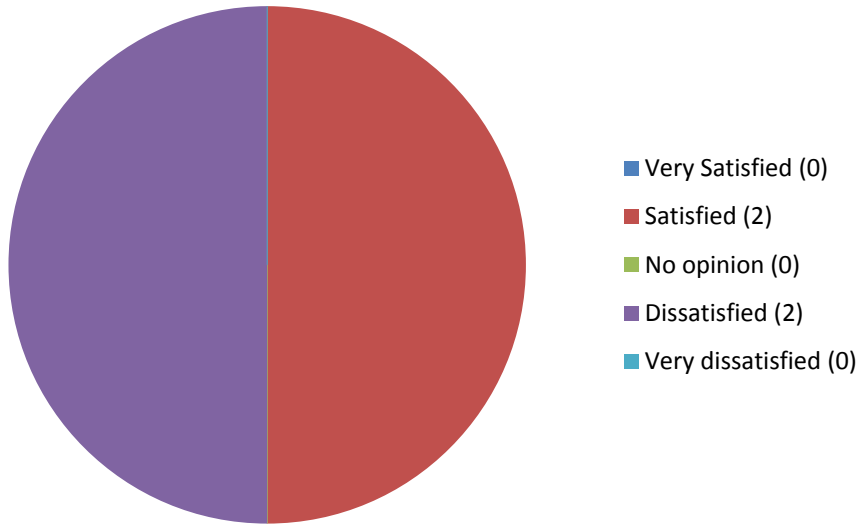

Safety of the park

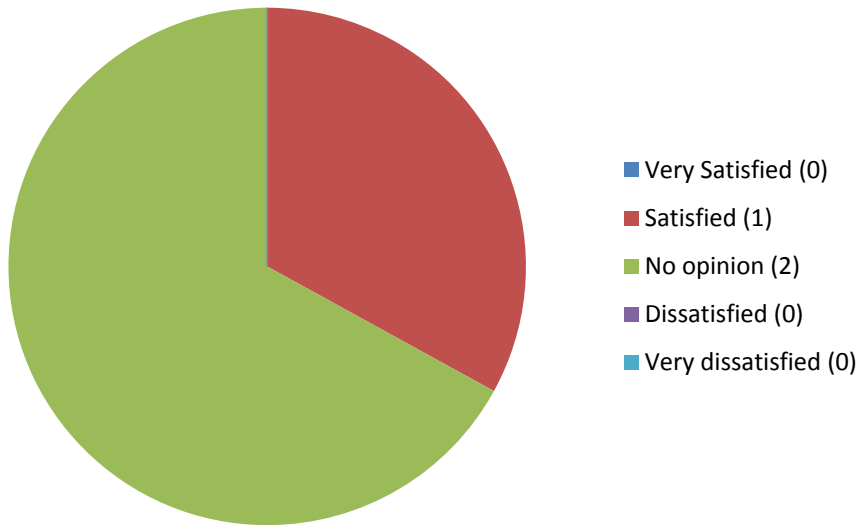
