


## **PUBLIC INPUT SUMMARY**

## Overview

A public meeting was held on September 9, 2017 to get feedback on planned improvements for Daumler Park. Residents in the area of Southern to Broadway, Price to the Tempe Canal (574 households) were invited to participate in the process. Twenty-one residents signed in at the meeting, but more residents were present in the park to look over the plans. Surveys were available at the meeting and online from September 9 through September 24, 2017. A total of 38 survey responses were received; 12 at the meeting and 26 online. City staff also received emails about the project, some from individuals who also filled out an online survey.


The proposed designs included different placements of amenities and residents were asked to provide comments on the playground layout as well as the style and materials for other amenities.

# Map of Survey Respondents




1. Of the two proposed Daumler Park playground area layouts, which do you prefer? (The budget is the same for both layouts.)




2. Should the playground be designed with a theme?




# 3. If yes, what theme?




4. The playground shade structure will be fabric, choose the style of roof you prefer.



5. The improvements include the addition of a picnic ramada. Please choose the type of roof you prefer.




6. If the ramada roof is a shade fabric, choose the style roof you prefer.




### **Cleanliness of Daumler Park**

- 8. I feel a lot of people visiting need to learn to clean up after themselves. There is often time trash left after parties or large group events. Diapers at the curb or street area.


## Safety of Daumler Park

I would be afraid to send my 14-year-old daughter there unaccompanied because of that, but I am not so sure there is anything the City of Tempe can do about that. I would really like to see the Par Fit Course, because I think it is something that would appeal to a wide range of ages.
- 4. We would love to see the sand go away. There are some sort of ground bees and ants living in it. Also neighborhood cats like to poop in it. It would be great to have rubber pad or mulch instead of sand. We are also ecstatic that our park is going to get a remodel!
- 5. I would love to see shade over equipment so it can be used year round. I would like to see the sand removed because it gets full of trash. I would like to see benches to sit on in the shade as well for parents.

I'm guessing it is above the price range allotted, but the zip line at mesa riverview park is AWESOME! Also, I don't love sand at parks. I prefer wood chips or the soft padding. We are excited for the improvements! We would spend a lot more time there I am sure if there was more things to do there! There were drug needles on the ground.
- 18. I'm not sure of more trash cans would help. There is often times trash problems. Even more so when the park is flooded. Maybe some sign reminders to help keep the park clean as a team. For everyone to clean up after themselves. Or signs of littering as a fine to spark people into action. Is there also any way to have security or police patrol the area at times cause sometimes there is strange activity at night or random condoms left at the curb area.

It would be interesting to see ALL the residents of Tempe Royal Palms "vote" on whether they wish a new and improved park or the beautifully, guiet and peaceful park that already exists. Hosting an early, Saturday morning meeting where most of the residents could not attend... not the best communication solution when trying to glean majority opinion from the residents. Nor is the long, impersonal dissertation response to one of our residents from the Mayors/Planning office regarding the improvement timeline and process...
