Dear Maryanne Corder Neighborhood Grant Committee,

Hudson Park (1430 S. Cedar St.) was the only park to get totally renovated in the last 15 years. We are very proud of our park. Because we have a splash pad, on the weekends and after school is out our park gets very crowded. There simply aren't enough permanent trash cans in the critical areas to handle the large parties that reserve the ramadas and take advantage of our play areas. The city did add some plastic cans but they are movable and wind up being used for soccer goals or skateboard barrels to be leaped over or knocked over. By Monday the cans are overflowing and the trash is blowing down the streets.

We think the best use of our grant money would be to add five more permanent cans but not just trash cans, we want to be pro-active and get people to think about recycling some of that trash too. See the attached map for placement. These cans will be secured onto existing concrete. We'd like to see them opposite the existing cans so they really stand out and people make a conscious effort to throw away only recyclable cans and bottles.

To help make citizens aware that these are recycle-only; the cans will be the same bright blue color like residents use at home. As per the city's request they will be 55-gallon so they are consistent with existing can sizes, the lids will also be metal and match in color and have small holes so people know they can't stuff a pizza box in there.


We want park users to concentrate on bottles and cans. To help with compliance and lower contamination we want to create eye catching full color graphics on the top and wrapping around the sides that are specific to the area that the cans will be placed. So the skate park can will have a message that teens can relate to. The splash pad can be more kid friendly, etc.. and all of them will be bilingual so the message will be clear to the diverse population that uses our park.

We plan on getting ideas and feedback from those targeted groups and the neighborhood so the message resonates and people feel more ownership and taking care of the park. Of course, all the graphic ideas of each can will be shown to the city prior to installation if we get the grant. The Tempe company that will print the graphics will also laminate them and guarantees they will last at least two years without fading in the Arizona sun.

The city has never tried this before in any pilot program but our park supervisor Shane Mueller and park planner David McClure are excited to try it and have approved of the style of can shown in our packet.

You can see by all the outreach and all the petition signatures that Hudson Manor really believes in this project. We received no negative feedback on this idea, which might be a first. Hudson wants to lead the way in increasing the amount of trash recycled in our parks and protecting our environment.
