Agenda Item 5 – Friends of the Tempe Public Library Report:

- Friends of the Tempe Public Library has signed an MOU with the Tempe Public Library to provide \$30,000 for the walls for the children's Literacy Center. Friends will hold back funds from future quarterly payments to the Library to fund the remaining balance of \$7,000.
- The Spring Osher Lifelong Learning semester began on Monday. There are 909 people enrolled in 25 classes (18 of which are multi-session) scheduled at the Library.
- The Osher Lifelong Learning National Resource Executive Director will visit the Library and the Friends-Connection Cafe on Friday for a lunch and conference with Osher@ASU staff, Friends and Kathy to view the Library campus and learn more about the partnership. This is part of a national tour of all 121 Osher sites throughout the country.

- Kathy Husser presented the following information.
 - The walls for the literacy center have been ordered and crews will begin cabling and demolition work soon. The project is expected to be completed by the end of May.
 - Comic Con took place on Jan. 27 and featured costumes, vendor booths, program panels/book discussions, a Nerf Zone obstacle course and family activities involved with comics and sci-fi/fantasy. Food trucks and the Tempe Book Bike were on hand for the all-day event, which was featured in *Tempe Today*, the *Arizona Republic* and *Phoenix New Times*. An estimated 4,000 people attended the event. The event will be renamed in the future to avoid trademark infringement.
