Agenda Item 3 – Public Appearances

Adrian Cascio, MYAC Advisor, congratulated the commissioners for recent events. Nomith Murari, former MYAC Chair, introduced himself. Mary Mezey, Social Services Supervisor, introduced herself as well.

Agenda Item 4 – Review and Approval of Minutes – March 27, 2018 Meeting

Liam Huggins read the minutes from the March 27, 2018 meeting.

Motion: Clara Moffit, MYAC Youth Town Hall Chair, motioned to approve the minutes as amended.

Second: Synthia Ramos seconded the motion. Decision: Minutes approved as amended.

Agenda Item 5 – Chair's Remarks

Eastwood commented on a positive experience at the Youth Fest awards. The commissioners discussed some of the inspiring stories from Youth Fest, particularly the Courage Award. Cascio then gave several comments encouraging the commissioners to attend Youth Leadership Day at Grand Canyon University from 9:00a.m. to 3:00p.m. Juliet Farr, Treasurer, shared a personal experience from Youth Leadership Day.

Agenda Item 6 – Tempe Innovation Proposal Presentation – Mary Mezey

Mary Mezey, Social Services Supervisor, gave a presentation on the Career Ready Tempe: Youth Workforce Pilot Program proposal. This program would enable Juniors and Seniors in High School to gain experience in various work environments and find jobs which they enjoy. The program will train both employers and youth to participate in a workplace. The program hopes to provide a stipend of approximately \$13.00 per hour. The program hopes to reach approximately 40 youth over the course of the 2-year pilot program. The funds will come from the City of Tempe's "Innovation Fund" Further information can be found in the Career Ready Tempe: Youth Workforce Pilot Program: City of Tempe Innovation Fund Proposal. Commissioners then discussed their opinions of the program and asked Mezey questions about the program.

Decision: On a unanimous vote, the Commission moves to recommend the Career Ready Tempe: Youth Workforce Pilot Program to the City of Tempe City Council.
