PUBLIC INPUT SUMMARY


Overview

A public meeting was held on May 5, 2018 for feedback on planned improvements for Arredondo Park. Residents in the area from the US-60 to Baseline, McClintock to Rural (963 residents) were invited to participate in the process via postcard. Notices were posted to Nextdoor to 245 households directing residents to both the meeting and the website. Park signs were also placed in the park announcing the meeting. Nine (9) people signed in for the meeting. Residents were asked to provide input on playground layout, theme, shade and ramada style, playground equipment, and park experience. Surveys were available at the meetings and online from May 5 through May 21, 2018. A total of 41 survey responses were received; 9 at the meeting and 32 online, 1 without an address.

Map of Survey Respondents




A metal hip roof was chosen for the ramada. Which ramada column material do you prefer?
 Option D - Stone Veneer




2. Break the tie! The playground shade structure will be fabric, choose the style of shade you prefer: **Hip Roof**



3. Should the shade structure be placed over the play structure or over the swings? **Over the Play Structure**






- Play Structure Option B (35)

- 3. Please add more and/or brighter lighting to the area. The existing light posts do not provide adequate lighting. Please enhance the lighting at this park for safety purposes.
- 4. Thank you for these awesome upgrades, the park is in dire need of it!
- 5. I'm not sure if I missed where it says what type of footing will be used, but I would LOVE to see something similar to the rubber surface at Scudder Park, where the entire playground is sand free. I think the rubber is safer for falls, not to mention more clean and safer for kids' eyes. I actually currently drive my kids to play at Scudder even though we live only a minute walk from Arredondo for this reason, but we are really looking forward to these improvements! Thank you!
- 6. It would be a good idea to replace the sand with a rubber flooring for the playground. It would eliminate the animals from going to the bathroom in the sand and give the playground a modern look.
- 7. Also add in the baseball glove cool concept but the other playground set seemed better for kids.
- 8. The City of Tempe does a great job with its parks. The chosen structures should maximize life of service. Building the structures to last, both functionally and aesthetically, should be the priority in choice. All of the choices look sound, functionally.
- 9. More trees! Shade is so important. Wish that nature theme was chosen. Kids gravitate towards sensory interaction areas and I don't see that in the design. We love the music and nature themes with items like chimes, bongos, and tire swings, too. Love the tire swings!

Option A on the play structure looks nice/modern & is different than the typical playground like in option B, but the large baseballs and mitt look like they are more for design rather than useful equipment. Although they make it look great, I'd rather see the money spent on expanding the playground to get more use out of the equipment since I'm sure there is a budget.
- 15. For the columns notched CMU block finish is nice if they can fit 2 table benches otherwise the metal post finish is nice too.

More lights

Better grass or rubber matting

Pet play area

Covered picnic table areas

And SWINGS! It seems there are never enough swings at newer parks and my kids love them.
