

SUBPOENA INFORMATION SHEET

The information on this sheet is for the purpose of providing basic references regarding the signing and service of subpoenas. This sheet is not a substitute for legal advice and if you have any questions, you will need to contact a lawyer, or check the appropriate statutes and rules which may be found on line or at a law library. Court staff cannot provide legal advice on how to prepare or serve a subpoena.

Subpoenas for witnesses for Civil Traffic Hearings, Code Enforcement Hearings, Criminal Trials, Order of Protection Hearings, or Injunction against Harassment Hearings:

1. Obtain a subpoena form from the Court's website or request a hardcopy from a court services specialist. Complete the information as requested.
2. Bring the form to the Court to have the Judge sign it at least two weeks before the trial date. Do not call the court to check on the status. Subpoenas will be signed and ready for pick up within two working days from the day it was dropped off. You will need to return to Court to pick up the signed subpoenas after that time period.
3. Serve the Subpoena

Service of Subpoenas Arizona Revised Statute 13-4072

You may serve a witness by anyone of the following methods:

1. **Personal Service:** A witness may be served by any person who is not less than 18 years of age. The party causing the subpoena to be served must comply with requirements of ARS 13-4072 C, D or E by providing a Certificate of Service as described in those sections stating when, where, how and to whom the subpoena was served and files the writing with the Court. A party is responsible for payment of all fees charged by the person serving the subpoena.
2. **Certified Mail:** For delivery to the addressee only, return receipt required. The sender must attach to the Certificate of Service a mailing receipt or electronic verification that the subpoena was delivered to the addressee or that a delivery attempt was made.
3. **First Class mail:** If the addressee is provided with a certificate of service and return card and the certificate of service and return card are returned by the addressee.

Witnesses should be served in a reasonable amount of time to ensure their attendance.

Subpoena Duces Tecum

This box on the subpoena form can be checked when a person is seeking to review documents/records or have those documents/records brought to court as potential evidence in a trial. Please note that for civil traffic hearings, you may only request this type of a subpoena for the production of records or documents for the actual trial date, absent extraordinary circumstances.
