


PUBLIC INPUT SUMMARY

Overview

A public meeting was held on October 17, 2018 for feedback on planned improvements to Indian Bend Park.. Residents in the area of McKellips to Curry, McClintock to Rural (1157 residents) were invited to participate in the process via postcard. Postcards were translated in Spanish. Notices and a poll were posted to Nextdoor to 246 households in 3 neighborhoods. Signs in English and Spanish were placed in the park announcing the public meeting. Eleven residents signed in at the meeting. Residents were asked to provide input on playground layout, theme, playground equipment, number of ramadas, and overall park experience. Surveys were available at the meetings and online from October 27, 2018 through November 10, 2018. A total of 18 survey responses were received; 4 at the meeting and 14 online, 2 from outside the service area, 4 without address data. In addition, parks staff visited the North Tempe Multi-Generational Center for the Boys and Girls Club Thanksgiving meal on November 19th and asked for participants to vote for their favorite piece of playground equipment. 133 residents voted.

Maps of Survey Respondents




Service Area Responses




1. Of the two proposed Indian Bend Park playground area layouts, which do you prefer? (The budget is the same for both layouts.)




2. The playground design for Indian Bend Park will include a play structure for 5-12 year-olds. Should this play structure be *traditional*, or *modern* (see examples)?



3. Should the playground be designed around a central theme?




If yes, what theme? (Examples include: nature, specific sports, animals, nautical, urban, historical, etc.)




4. Please list in order of importance the top five (5) pieces of equipment you would like to see in Indian Bend Park:

5. Indian Bend Park is eligible for new picnic ramadas. Please choose the number and size of ramadas you would prefer:






- Option 3 (Both courts striped for tennis) (1)


Cleanliness of Indian Bend Park




Safety of Indian Bend Park
