Item 4. Welcome New Commissioner – Tracey Maye

Commissioners and Strategic Management staff introduced themselves to the new Commissioner Tracey Maye.

Item 5. Presentation: Foundation for Blind Children, Julie Oliver.

A presentation on the Foundation for Blind Children (FBC) was provide by Employment Services Coordinator Julie Oliver. The presentation included information about services provided to both adults and children, by FBC. Employment related training is one of the services provided which covers travel skills, computer and phone skills and self-advocacy.

They work with the Arizona Department of Economic Security Vocational Rehabilitation Services Administration (VR) to provide a 12-month program that helps students work through barriers to college and employment. They also work with the Disability Resource Center at ASU to help students with vision loss.

Ms. Oliver also worked with Tempe in evaluating the ADA Wayfinding project with Orientation and Mobility Specialist Jay Whipple.

The biggest barriers to employment are misperception. "Vision Loss is a diagnosis, not a disability." Vice Chair Irene Mochel: It seems that fear and perception of liability make HR nervous about hiring people with disabilities. Sometimes when they change computer systems it can leave people behind who required various accommodations. There is a wealth of programs now that help with the effects of vision loss. There are apps that read food can labels. There are bump dots that help orient. There are assistants that can help someone with vision loss organize their own homes.

FBC also provides participants with help regarding:
