<u>ACTION</u>: Request approval to abate public nuisance items at the TL Qik Stop Property located at 3233 S. 48th Street. The applicant is the City of Tempe – Code Compliance.

FISCAL IMPACT: \$475.00 for abatement request: Landscape cleanup, trash, debris & transient shelter removal, graffiti removal.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff – Approval of 180 day open abatement

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: City of Tempe – Code Compliance Section requests approval to abate items in violation of the Tempe City Code at the TL QIK STOP PROPERTY. The details of this case represent several months of correspondence for compliance with the property owner. Staff requests the approval of abatement of the following nuisance items under Complaint CM200542: Landscape cleanup, trash, debris & transient shelter removal, graffiti removal.

COMMENTS:

Code Compliance is requesting approval to abate the TL Qik Stop Property located at 3233 S. 48th Street, in the PCC-1, Planned Commercial Center Neighborhood district. This case was initiated 03/26/20, after which Code Compliance has attempted to obtain compliance through correspondence with the property owner regarding violations of the Tempe City Code.

Without the intervention of abatement the property will continue to deteriorate. It is therefore requested that the City of Tempe Community Development Hearing Officer approve a 180 day open abatement of this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code.

FINDINGS:

3/26/2020 Inspected property and found over height grass and weeds, trash and debris, and graffiti scattered throughout the property. Notice to comply mailed to owner.

4/27/2020 Mailed final notice to comply to owner.

5/12/2020 Mailed updated notice to comply to other possible owner address.

5/26/2020 Issued civil citation.

6/1/2020 The Code Compliance Division received an additional complaint for trash and debris on the property.

6/9/2020 Owner failed to appear for court.

6/11/2020 Posted notice of intent to abate to property and mailed to property owner.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

I recommend an abatement of the nuisance violations at the property at 3233 S 48th St due to property owner's failure to bring property into compliance with Tempe City Code 21-3.B.1, 21-3.B.8, and 22-105.A. Ms. Nguyen has been given ample time to come into compliance and maintain the property. The property owner has been issued a civil citation and has failed to appear to court. There has been no indication that the property owner will bring the property into compliance. The property represents a health hazard and an eyesore to the community.

Without the intervention of abatement the property will continue to deteriorate. I therefore make a request to the City of Tempe Community Development Hearing Officer for authorization to abate this public nuisance in accordance with section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code and authorization of multiple abatements for a period not to exceed one hundred eighty (180) days from the previous abatement order.

This office will submit this complaint to the Community Development Abatement Hearing Officer located at the Tempe City Council Chambers on **07/21/2020**. We are requesting Hearing Officer Authorization to abate this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code by removal and repair of:

- 1. REMOVE GRASS AND WEEDS FROM THE GRAVEL AREAS AND ASPHALT.
- 2. REMOVE TRASH, DEBRIS, AND TRANSIENT MAKESHIFT SHELTER FROM PROPERTY.
- 3. REMOVE GRAFFITI FROM PERIMETER AND BUILDING WALLS. PAINT NEEDS TO BE COMPATIBLE WITH EXISTING PAINT COLOR.

As owner of the property, you have thirty (30) days after receipt of this letter to abate or correct the violation. If the violations have not been corrected within thirty days, our office will proceed with the abatement process.

Upon receipt of the Hearing Officer approval to abate this public nuisance, the necessary work will be performed at the expense of the property owner. The cost of this work will be \$475.00. In addition to the actual cost of abatement, an administrative charge of fifteen (15) percent of the actual cost of abatement or three hundred (\$300) dollars, whichever is greater, for expenses incurred by the city for abatement procedures, and the cost of recording liens and releases will be charged. The recorded lien may bear interest at the legal rate for judgments in the State of Arizona. Administrative charges and the cost of recording liens and releases shall become a lien on the property whether or not the public nuisance is abated by the City.
