Outside of business hours, a group of more than 100 people requires 1 or 2 off-duty officers (at the discretion of the Tempe Police Department) at \$36.42 per hour. Business hours are defined as weekdays between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. excluding holidays. As currently defined in the City Code, a community partner is a government agency, entities that have a current Intergovernmental Agreement with the City or tenants of the Transportation Center. Groups can not apply to become a community partner.
