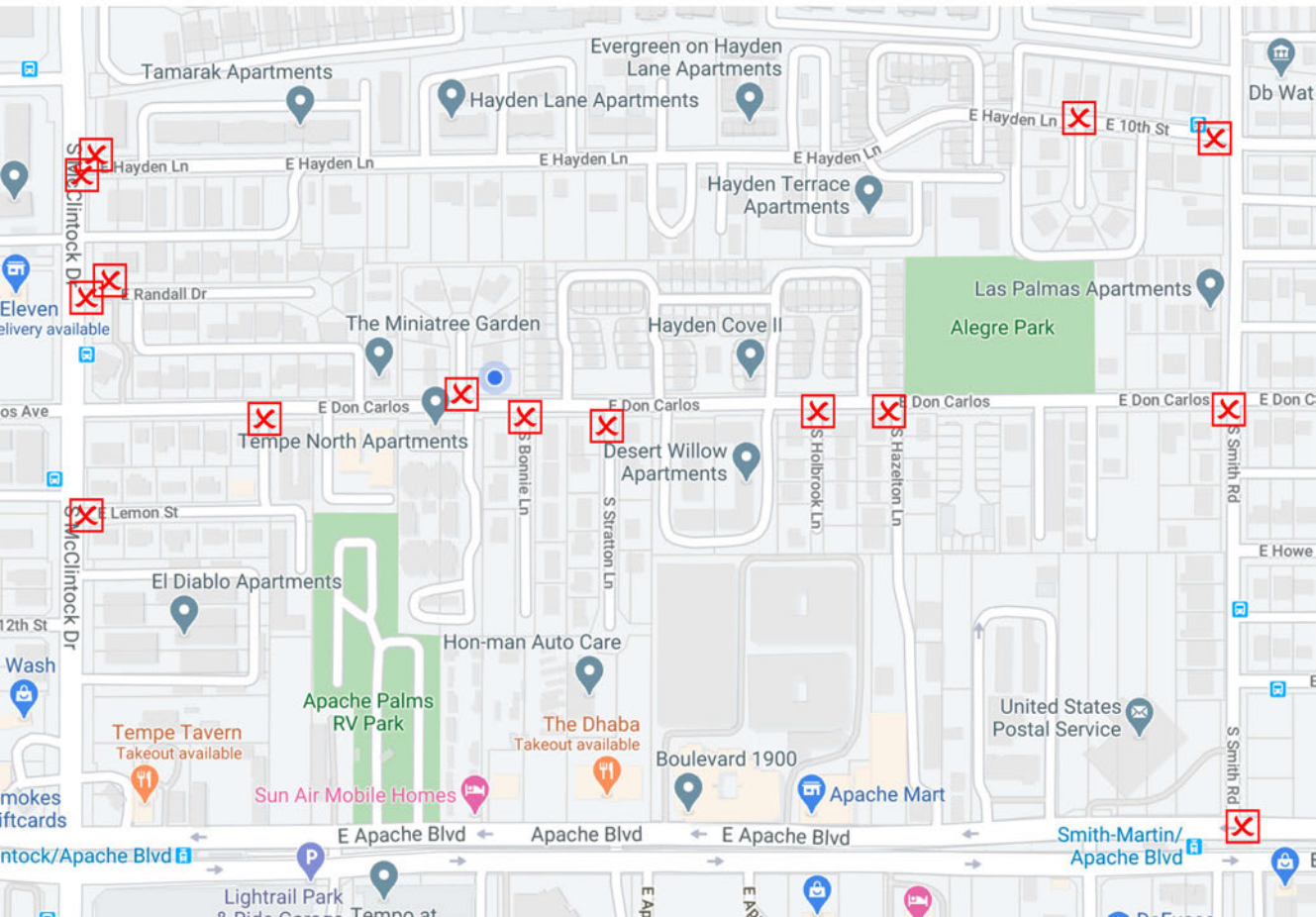

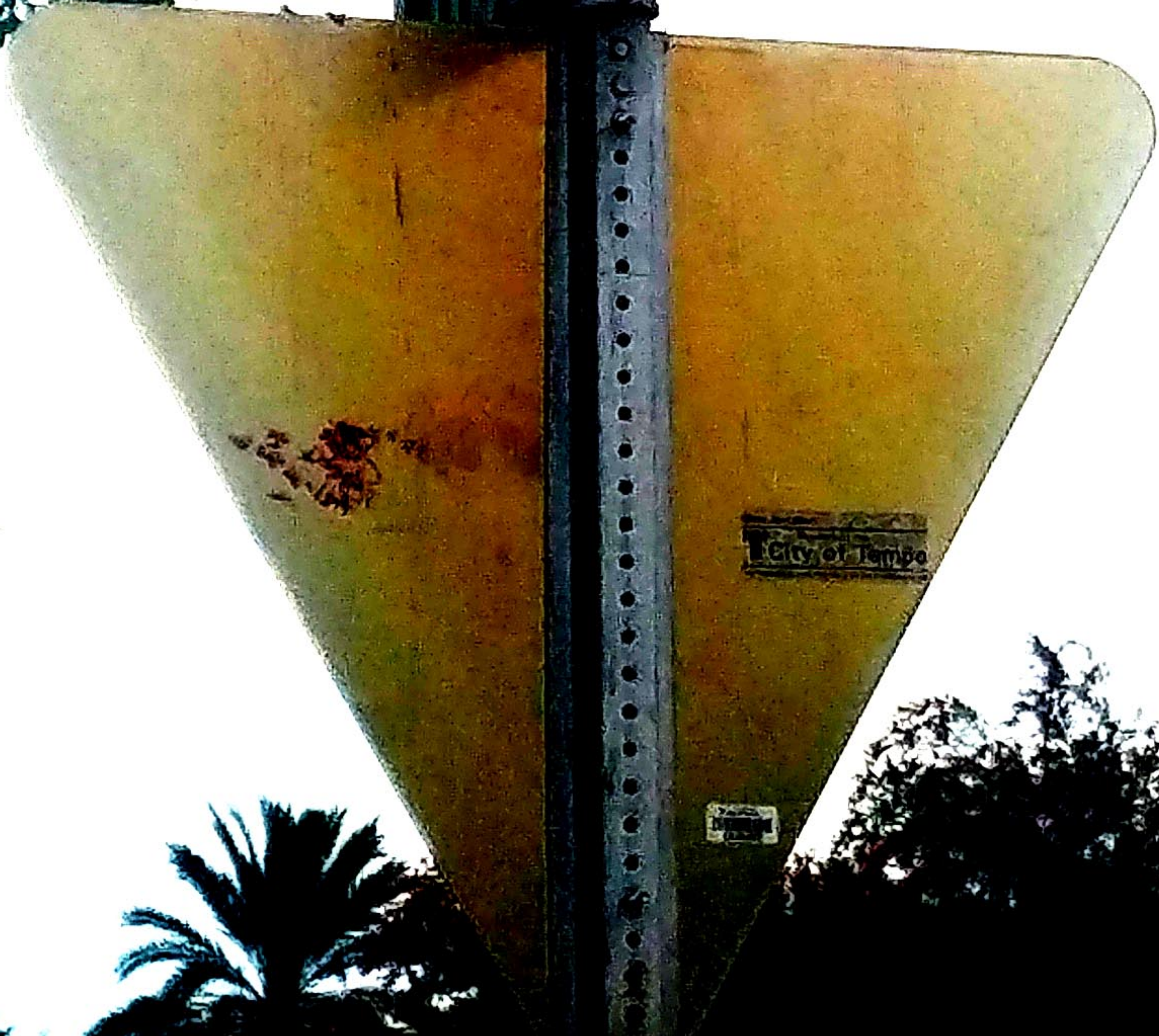

I have started looking into our sign topper proposal, and based on google maps, I have counted 17 cross streets where we would potentially have street signs. I had questions about two of them:

- Rancho El Dorado shows up on Google maps, but I'm not sure if it's technically a street. It's a loop that comes off of Apache. Would this need a sign topper? **Optional- you can have as many or as few as you want**

- Apache & Smith doesn't currently have a street sign. Would we skip this in our sign toppers, or would we need to include requesting a street sign as part of our proposal? **I'd include it**

Can you confirm that the sign toppers are still \$54 each? This is the number I saw in the proposals that were approved for the 2019-2020 year. **YES this is correct**
