



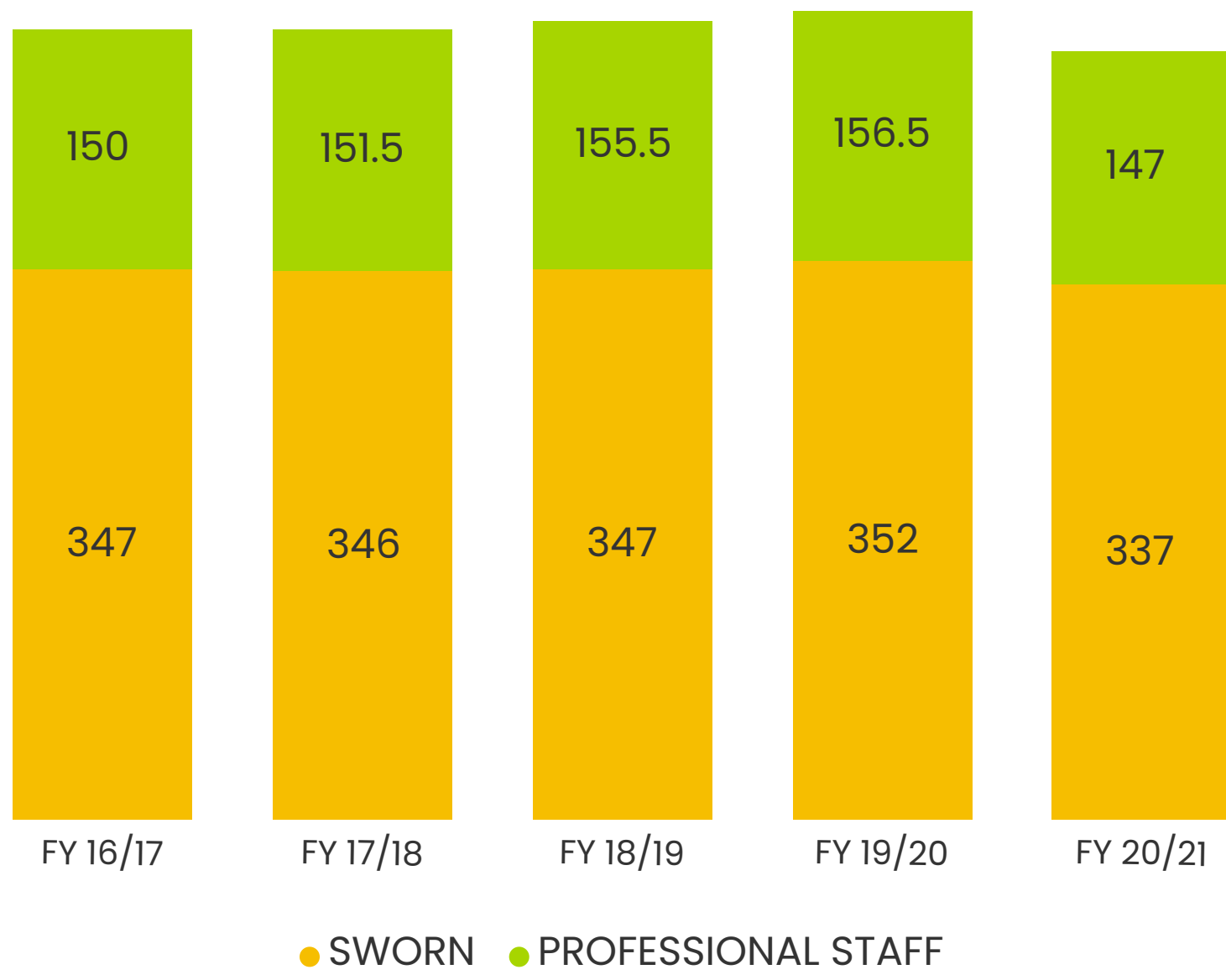

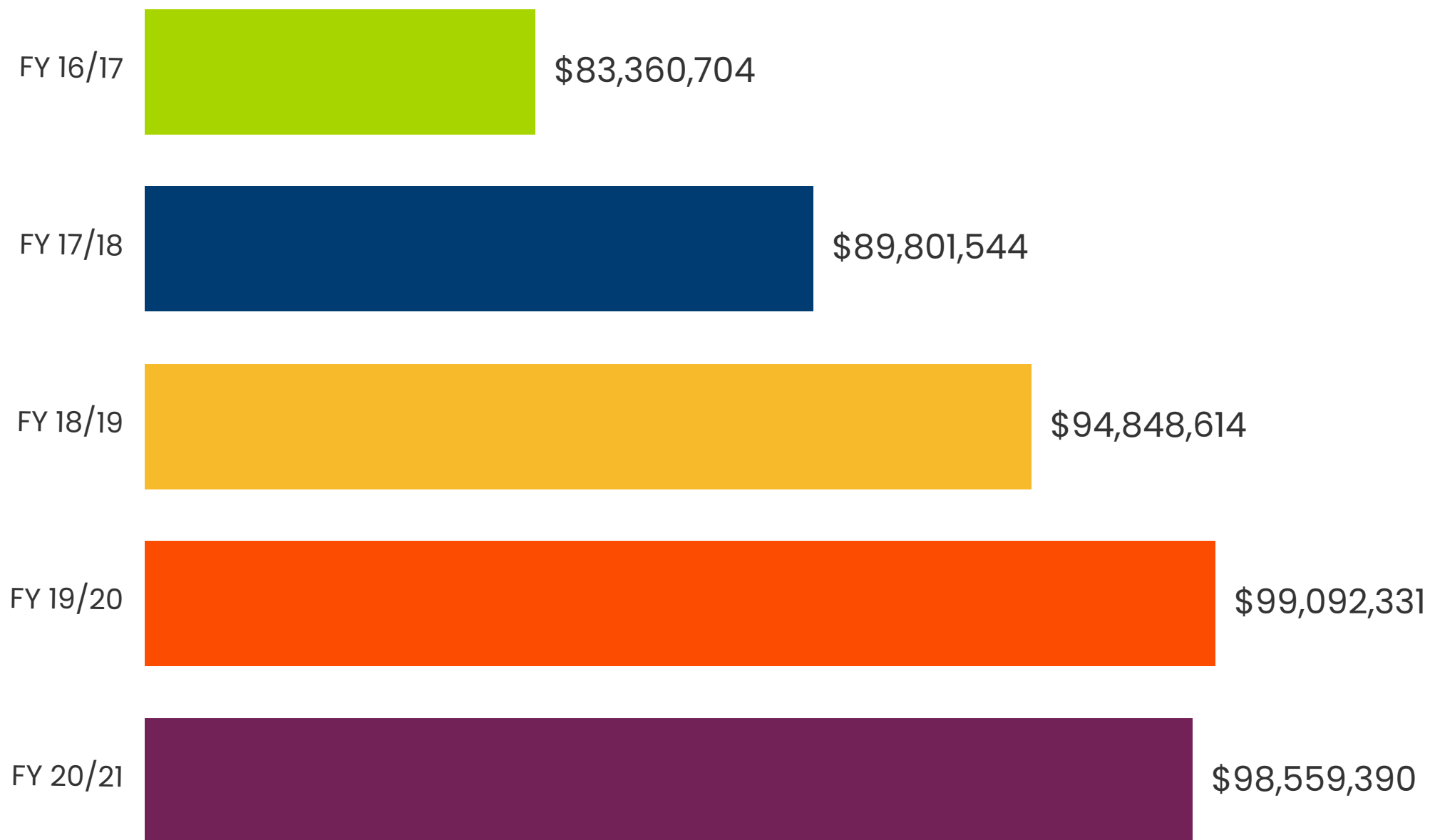

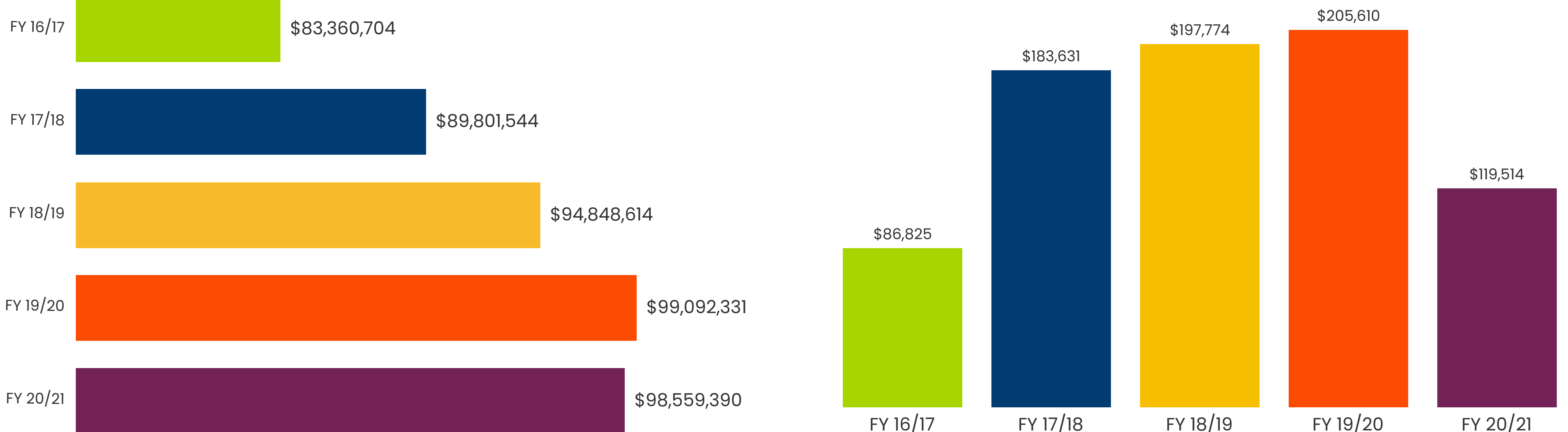

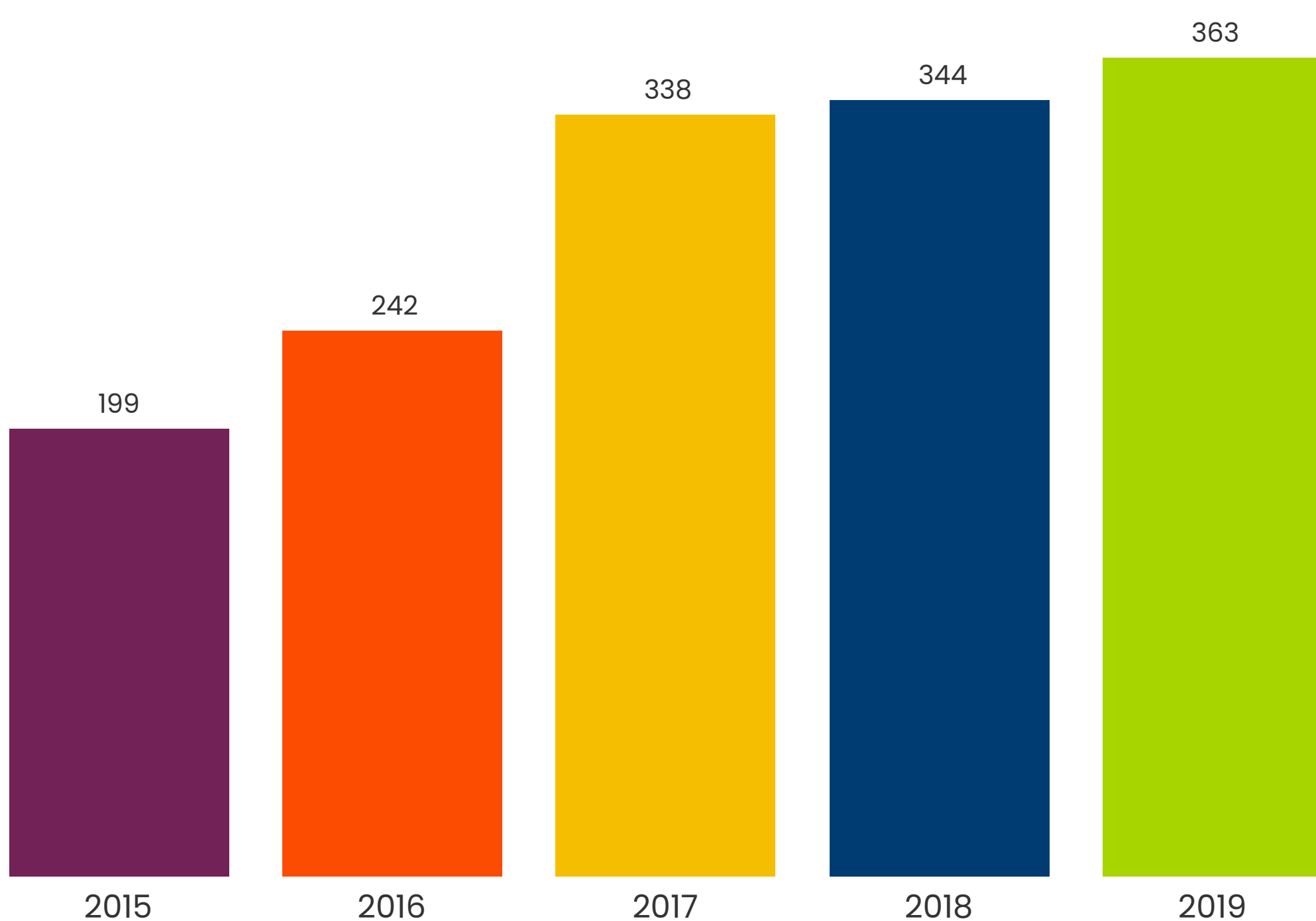

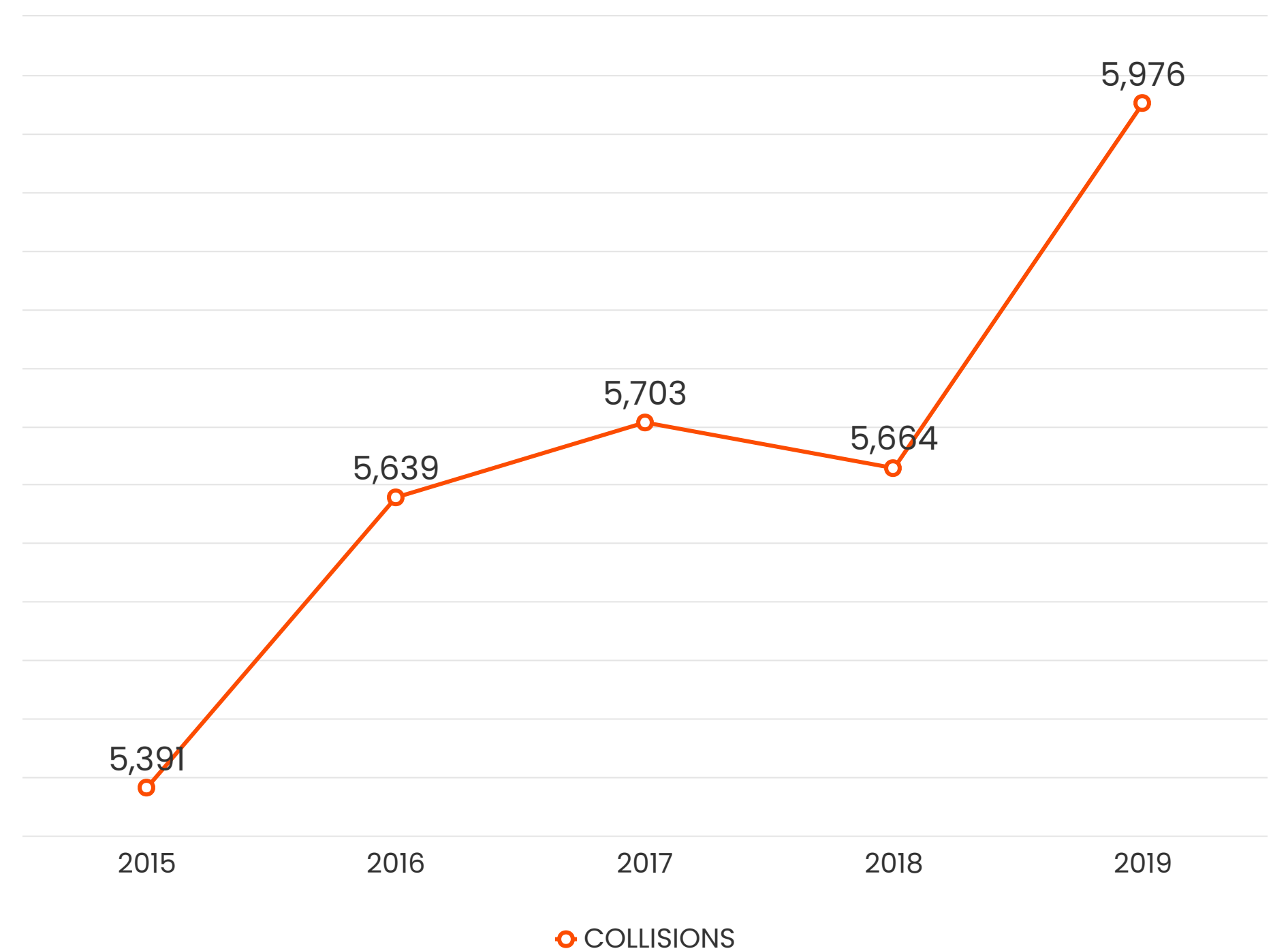

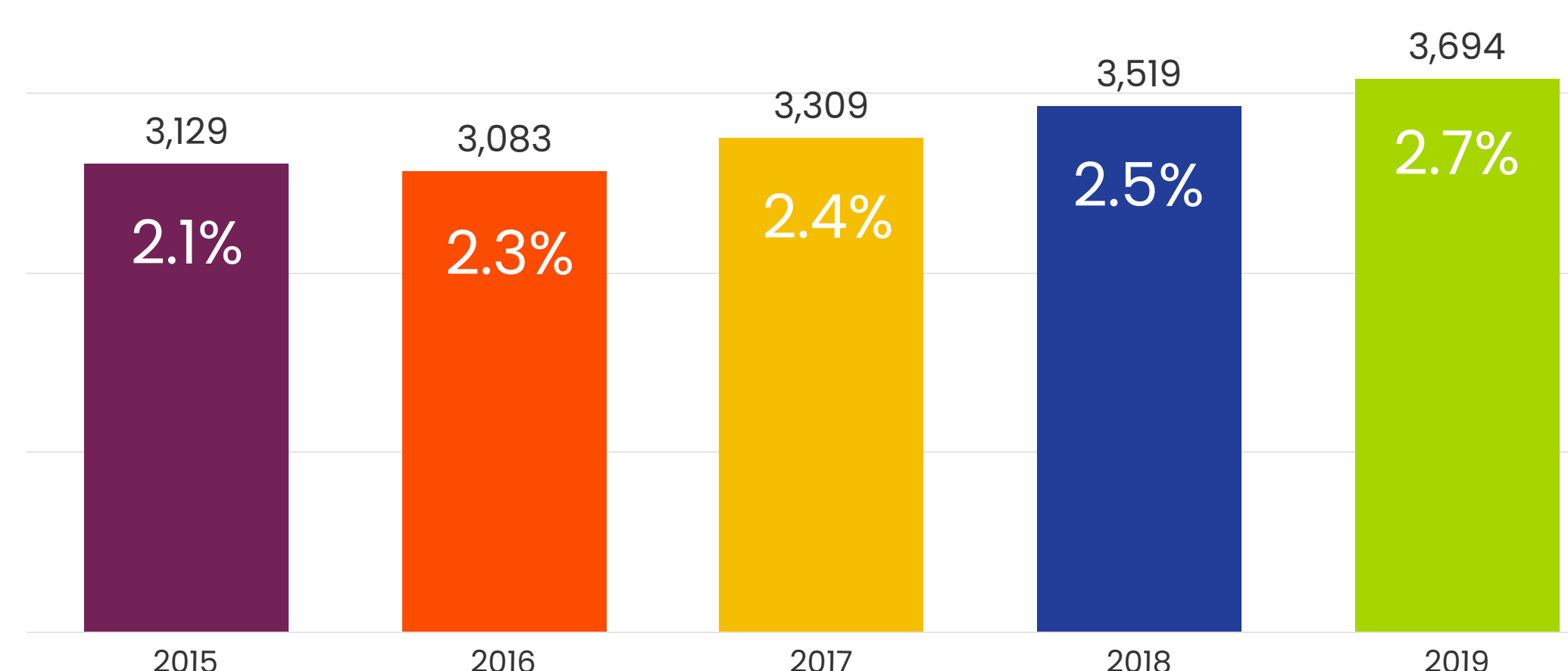
Uniform crime reporting (UCR) is a collective effort of law enforcement to present a nationwide view of crime. Agencies provide summarized reports on ten Part I offenses; these Part I offenses are murder and non-negligent homicide, rape, robbery, aggravated assault, burglary, motor vehicle theft, larceny-theft, arson and human trafficking. These offenses were chosen because they are serious crimes, they occur with regularity in all areas of the country, and they are likely to be reported to police.
