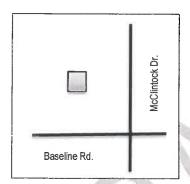
Agenda Item: 5

<u>ACTION</u>: Request approval to abate public nuisance items at the Campos Property located at 1336 E. Fremont Drive. The applicant is the City of Tempe – Code Compliance.

FISCAL IMPACT: \$2504.00 for abatement request: landscape cleanup, remove dead tree.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff – Approval of 180 day open abatement

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: City of Tempe – Code Compliance Section requests approval to abate items in violation of the Tempe City Code at the CAMPOS PROPERTY. The details of this case represent several months of correspondence for compliance with the property owner. Staff requests the approval of abatement of the following nuisance items under Complaint CE204343: landscape cleanup, remove dead tree.

COMMENTS:

Code Compliance is requesting approval to abate the Campos Property located at 1336 E. Fremont Drive, in the R1-6, Single Family Residential district. This case was initiated 07/02/20, after which Code Compliance has attempted to obtain compliance through correspondence with the property owner regarding violations of the Tempe City Code.

Without the intervention of abatement the property will continue to deteriorate. It is therefore requested that the City of Tempe Community Development Hearing Officer approve a 180 day open abatement of this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code.

FINDINGS:

07/02/2020 The Code Compliance Division received a complaint for deteriorated landscape and deteriorated pool. Inspected the property and found a pool with green water in the bottom of it, dead vegetation in the front of the property, tree debris and miscellaneous items in the back yard. Notice to comply was mailed to the owner.

07/23/2020 Re-inspected the property. There has been no change to the property except for adding in dead tree limbs to the notice. A final notice was mailed.

08/11/2020 Inspected the property and no change to the back yard. The front yard was complete. A pink hanger was hung on the door asking for compliance or contact by 8/14/2020 to avoid a citation.

08/20/2020 Upon inspection, noticed the tree appeared to be completely dead in the back yard. Went ahead and mailed another notice to include this large dead tree.

09/25/2020 Inspected the property. The pool is empty of water. The back-yard landscape is still not complete including the dead tree. There has been no contact from the owner. Issued a citation for the landscape. Pictures were taken to show the condition of the property.

10/08/2020 Received bids for an abatement cleanup to include the landscape. The hearing is scheduled for November 17th, 2020

RECOMMENDATIONS:

I recommend an abatement of the nuisance violation at the property located at 1336 E. Fremont Dr. The property owner has failed to bring the property into compliance with Tempe City Code 21-3-b.8. Mr. Campos has been given ample time. The property represents an eyesore and health and safety issue to the community.

Without the intervention of abatement, the property will continue to deteriorate. I therefore make a request to the City of Tempe Community Development Hearing Officer for authorization to abate this public nuisance in accordance with section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code and authorization of multiple abatements for a period not to exceed one hundred eighty (180) days from the previous abatement order.

This serves as notification of the City of Tempe's intentions regarding the abatement of code violations on the following described property:

This office will submit this complaint to the Community Development Abatement Hearing Officer to be placed on the Hearing Officer agenda of November 17th, 2020 located at the Tempe Council Chambers, 31 E 5th Street, at 5pm. We are requesting Hearing Officer Authorization to abate this public nuisance in accordance with Section 21-53 of the Tempe City Code by removal and repair of:

CC 21-3.b.8

Landscaping that is substantially dead, damaged or characterized by uncontrolled growth or presents a deteriorated or slum-like appearance.

If the violations have not been corrected within thirty (30) days, our office will proceed with the abatement process. As owner of the property, you have thirty (30) days after receipt of this letter to abate or correct any violation as described below:

CC 21-3.b.8

a. Remove all tree debris. Cut all over height grass/weeds. Cut dead tree down to ground level.

Upon receipt of the Hearing Officer approval to abate this public nuisance, the necessary work will be performed at the expense of the property owner. The cost of this work will be \$ 2504.00. In addition to the actual cost of abatement, an administrative charge of fifteen(15) percent of the actual cost of abatement or three hundred (\$300) dollars, whichever is greater, for expenses incurred by the City for abatement procedures, and the cost of recording liens and releases will be charged. The recorded lien may bear interest at the legal rate of judgments in the State of Arizona. Administrative charges and the cost of recording liens and releases shall become a lien on the property whether or not the public nuisance is abated by the City.
